Fall Sports

Sports are offered to all 7th and 8th grade students.

Practice start dates for fall sports are:

- Football Monday, August 29th at 3:00 pm.
- Soccer August 31st at 2:40 pm.
- Volleyball August 31st at 2:40 pm.
- Cross country August 31st at 2:40 pm.

To be eligible for practice, all students must have a current sports physical on file in the office, be completely registered online, and have their sports user fee/ASB purchased. Each sports physical expires after 2 years but registration needs to be completed, and a user fee needs to be paid every season that a student participates in a sport. *Sports User Fee - \$30.00 (\$.00 if qualified for free/reduced prices)

*ASB - \$15.00 (\$.00 if qualified for free/reduced prices) A one-time purchase of the ASB membership lasts all year long and is a requirement for students participating in sports and/or clubs.

Chromebook

All 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students will have a KSD owned Chromebook checked out to them for the 2022/23 school year. The success of the implementation will require a lot of teamwork from staff, students and families. Below are some key items all students and parents need:

- Students and parents/guardians must read and review the Chromebook Policy before students are allowed to check out their Chromebook.
- Parents/guardians must read and accept or decline the annual Insurance/Maintenance policy (\$30.00 per year or \$15.00 if child qualifies for free/reduced lunch).

Reminders

Class Schedules: Students must be accompanied by an adult to pick up their class schedule at Open House. If you unable to attend, students will receive their class schedule on the first day of school.

Immunizations: The 6th grade immunization requirement is for all students to receive their Tdap after their 11th birthday. This needs to be completed prior to starting school (if turning 11 after school starts, the student has 2 weeks to get the shot). Unless you are exempt, please be aware that no student is exempt from the MMR vaccine and must have it prior to starting school. 6th grade students must have their immunizations complete prior to receiving their class schedules.

Bus Routes: School bus routes are available on the KSD website under Transportation. The Tri-City Herald will also publish school bus routes the Sunday before school starts, August 28th.
