OUR TEAMS GOAL



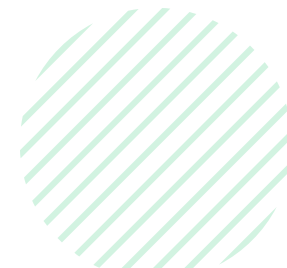
Provide EVERY student with the knowledge and resources they need to become college and career ready.

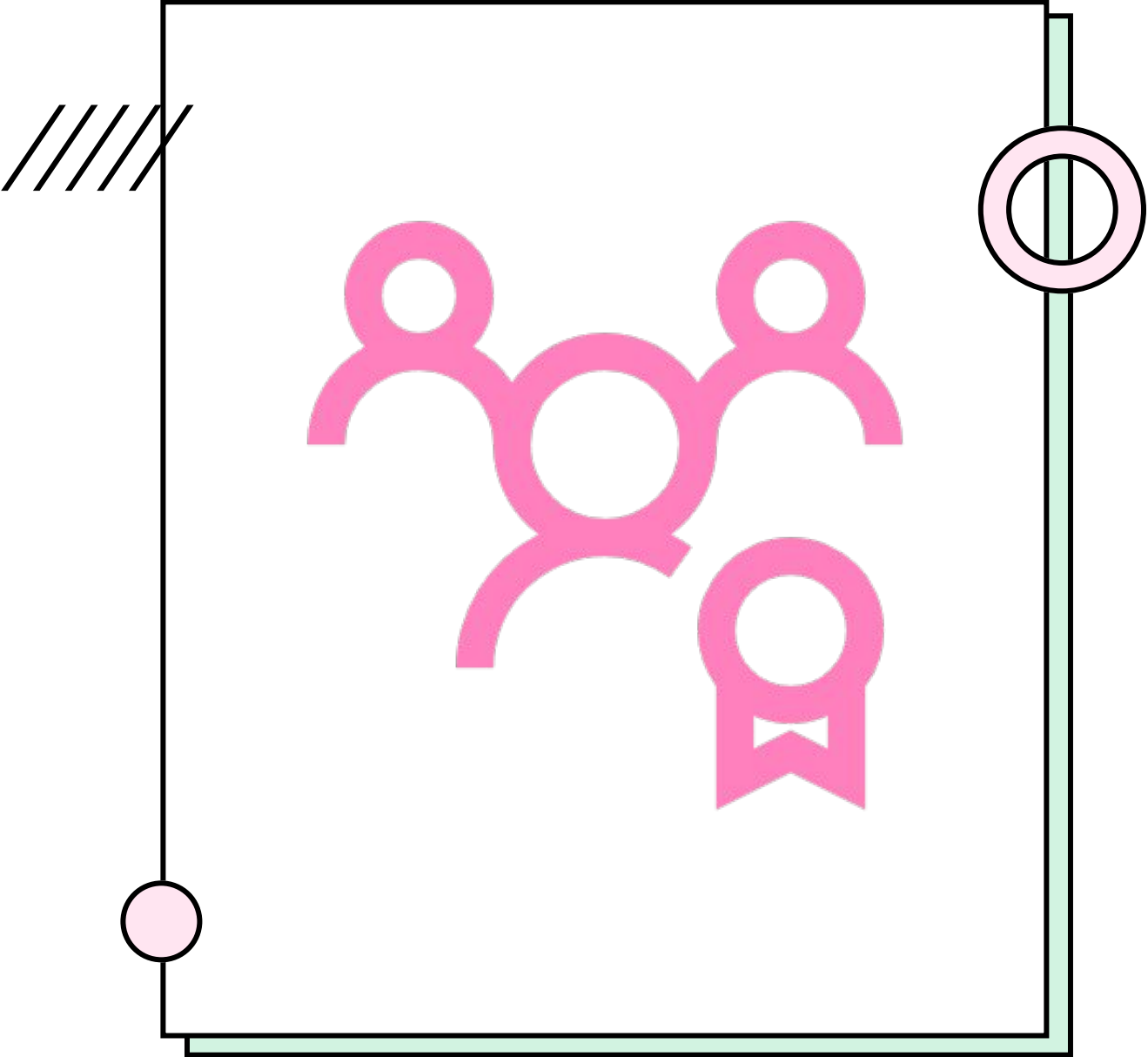

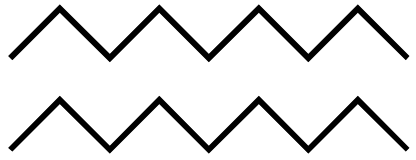

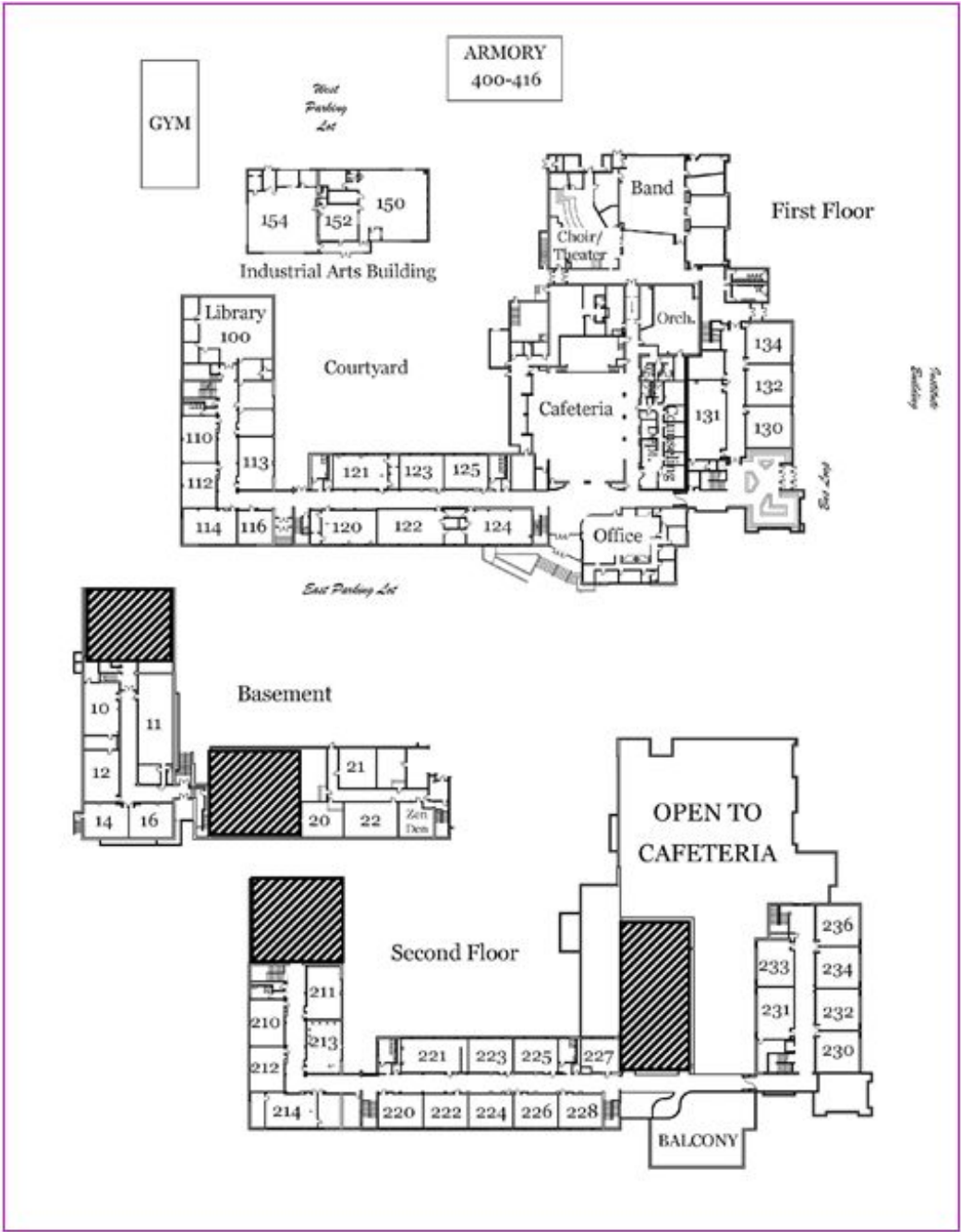

CDJH Campus Map Breakdown

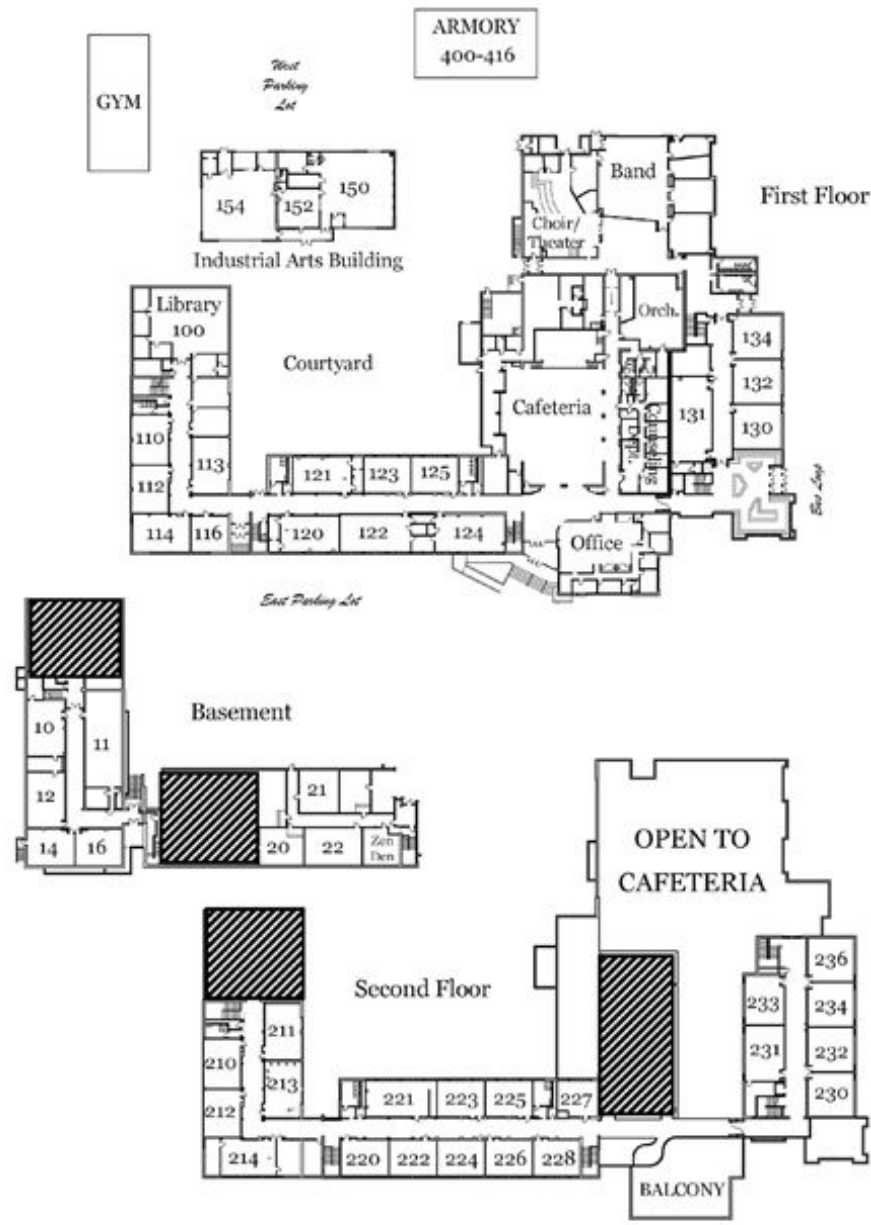

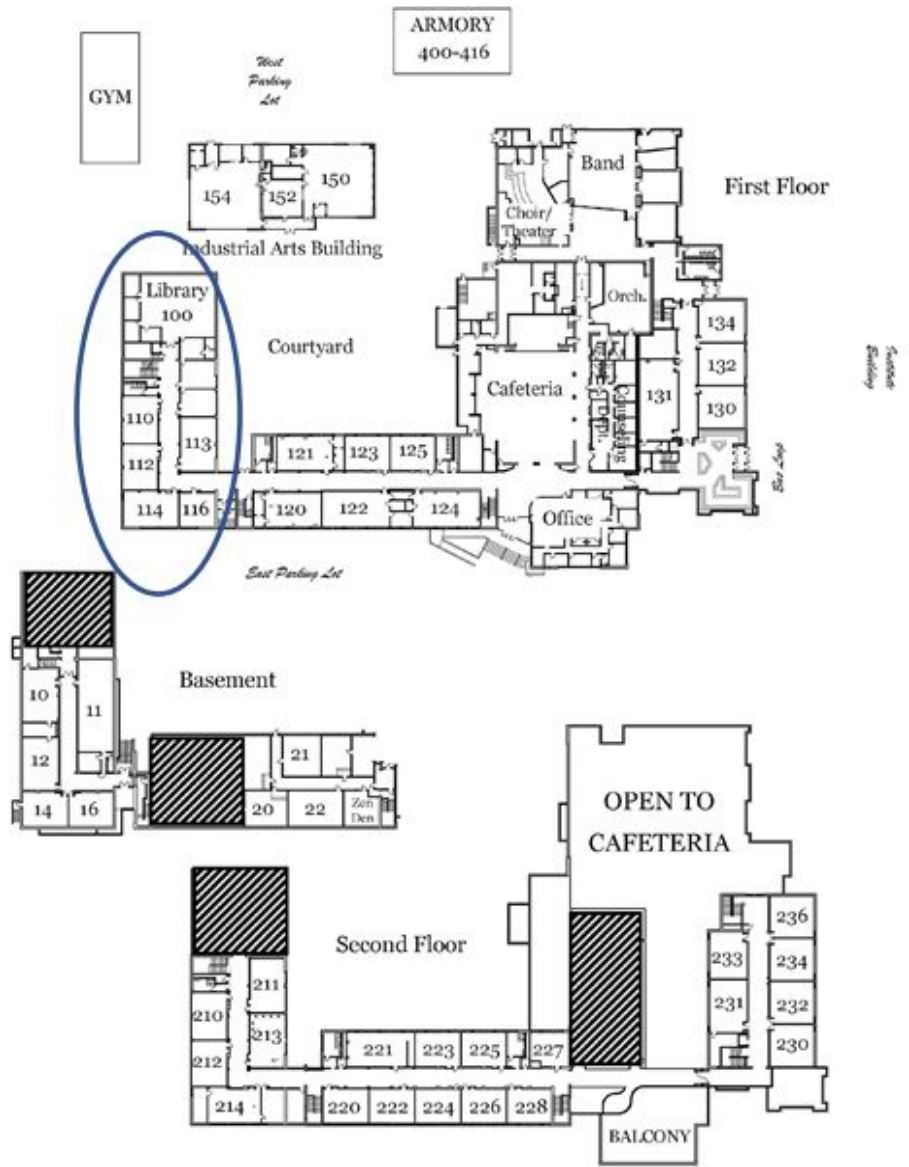
CDJH has 3 Floors:

- Basement = Double Digits

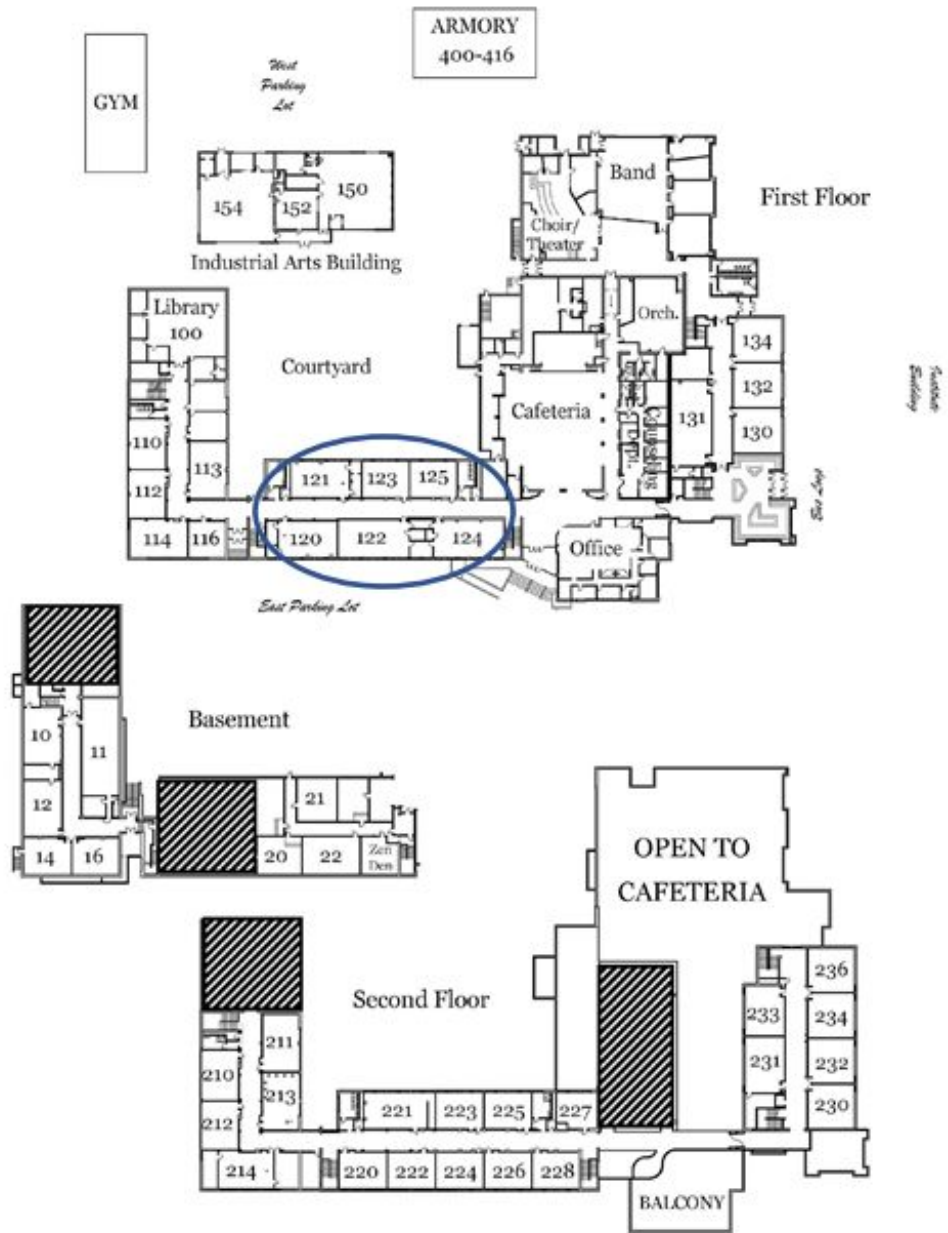
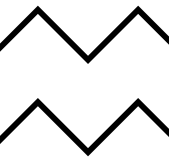

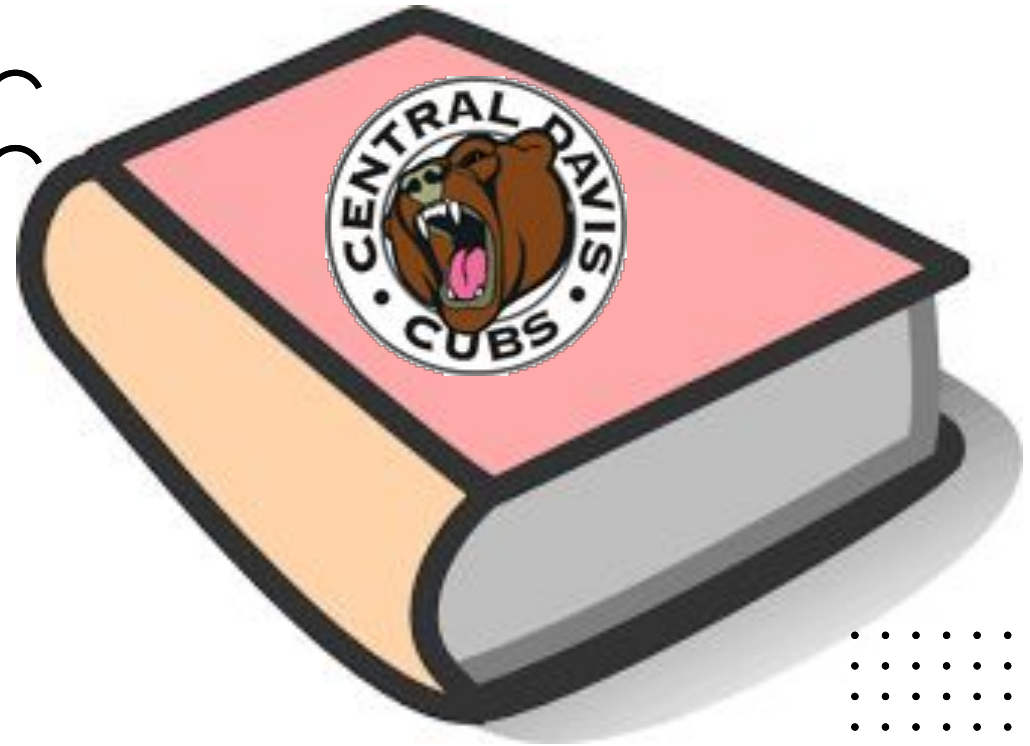
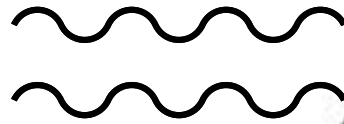
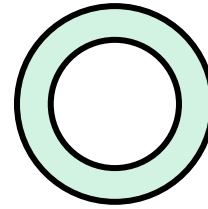


All students will be assigned a locker

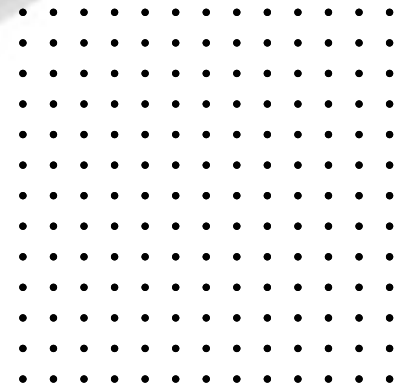
Student may have to share a locker depending upon availability

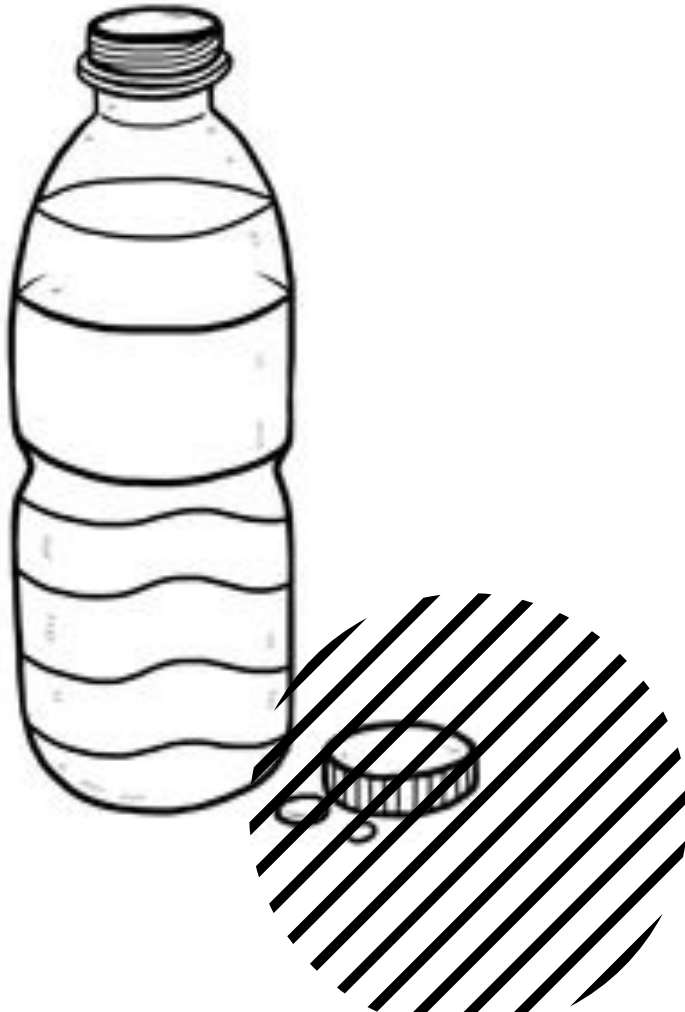
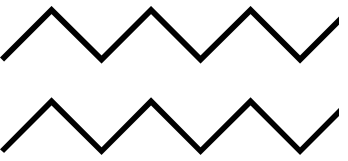

- Drinking fountains are located near the Library & in the Counseling Dept. hallway.



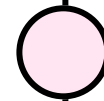
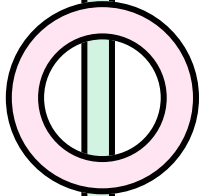

- Class schedules will not be changed for lunch preference.



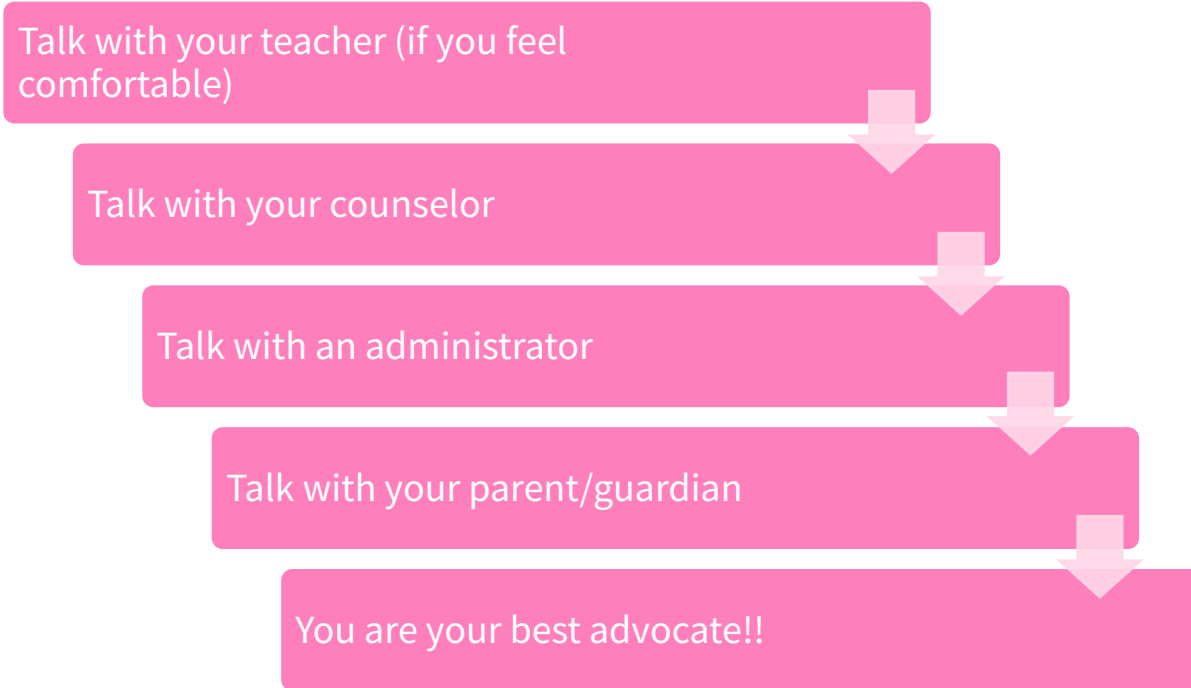

If you have an issue in a class with a classmate or with a teacher, you should:





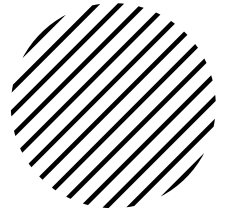
Relationship Skills

- You can be rewarded for good behavior with our Cub Pride cards.





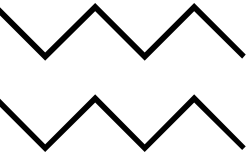
Get Involved

Social Media- be careful what you post & don't accept friend requests of individuals you do not know.



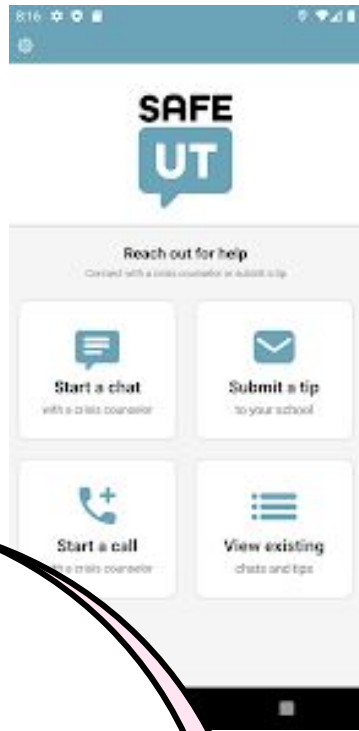
Gossiping only causes more problems. You can always come to the counselor or administrator for help with friends.



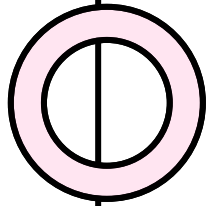
Recording of photographing others- if it will embarrass the individual, DON'T DO IT!

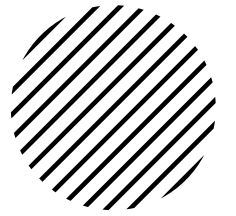
