Covid-19 Protocols

- @ HomePre-screening questions of symptoms should be done at home before coming to campus.
 - Fever over 100.4
 - Chills, Cough, or difficulty breathing
 - Shortness of breath
 - Persistent headaches
 - Sore throat
 - Recent loss of taste or smell
 - Been exposed to someone who has tested positive for Covid-19

Covid-19 Protocols

Testing

- Testing will be begin on Wednesday <u>August 31st</u>,
 2022. And will be optional.
 - Students can tests as early as 7:30am every
 Wednesday till 1:30 pm.
 - We will be monitoring cases and follow LA County of Public Health.

Attendance (Absence Procedures)

- Parents/Guardians must <u>call or email</u> the attendance office between 7:30 am and 8:30 am <u>each day</u> the student is absent.
- **Upon returning to school** after an absence, the student must bring a note from parent or a doctor's note to the Attendance office.

Attendance (Absence Note Content)

- · Student's name and grade
- · Date(s) of absence
- · The explicit reason for absence
- The signature of the parent/guardian and the phone number(s) at which parent/guardian may be contacted during the school day.
- · Upon receiving the note, the attendance office will then excuse the absence, otherwise it will remain unexcused.

Types of Absences (Excused vs. Unexcused)

Excused Absences

- Illness*
- Medical/Dental appointments*
- Funerals
- Quarantine
- Court appearances*
- Approved school activities (ie. retreats, sporting events, school sponsored field trips)

*Must provide official doctor/court documentation

Unexcused Absences

- No doctor's/court note upon return to school
- Vacation
- Outside organization sports teams

Student Checkout Process (Main Office)

Step 1 Notify Main Office

- Parent note submitted before 7:50am
 - Student released when indicated on note
- Parent phone call to main office
 - Student will be called down upon parent arrival

Step 2: Sign Out Student

- PMA will release student to Parent/Guardian or any of the 3 emergency contacts
- All parents/guardians and emergency contacts MUST provide a photo ID to check out students

Dress Code

PMA Dress Code: Standard Uniform

- Polo with PMA logo

Dress Code

PMA Dress Code: Formal Uniform

 Black Pants Skirt (for girls), Oxford Shirt, Vest, Pullover or Cardigan Sweater, School Tie, White Long Socks (Girls), Black socks (Boys), Dress Shoes

- Jeans (No torn or ripped jeans)
- Shirts (PMA)
- Shoes

Jewelry, Piercings, & Accessories

<u>Girls</u>

Earrings: Two pairs of earrings only.

- No larger than two (2) inches in diameter.
- No other visible part of the body may have an earring or stud in it (e.g. eyebrows, nose, lips, belly button, tongue, etc.)

Boys

Earrings: not permitted

Bracelets: not permitted

Tattoos:

Tattoos must be completely covered at all times while on campus or at off-campus school activities.

Hats and Caps:

No head covering maybe worn in the building.
Only PMA hats/caps may be worn outside
during the school day

Phones, earpods & Electronic Devices

A) Use of Personal Electronic Technology Devices (PTD) pg.77

All extraneous personally owned technology devices (PTD), including, but not limited to, Smartphones with App capability, gaming devices, headsets, PCs, Macbooks, laptops, mobile presenters, wireless tablets (iPad, Samsung, Galaxy, Kindle), digital audio and video recorders, iPod Touch, texting calculators, phones with cameras, or digital cameras are to be used only when permission has been granted by legitimate authority for educational purposes. This includes devices that are run using commercially available networks. The use of SnapChat, Tik Tok, Facetime, and etc on PTD are not allowed at all during classes, school hours and at school grounds and facilities.

B) Headphone/Earbuds Policy pg. 51

Students are to abstain from using headphones/earbuds in communal areas on campus in an effort to improve school culture and community engagement

C) COMMUNICATION DEVICE/CELL PHONE POLICY pg. 51


All communication devices, text message units, cell phones, electronic tablets and laptop computers are on the list of student property that can be confiscated by the dean and not returned until the last week of school. Cell phones and laptop computers etc. can be returned sooner to parents who come to the office to pick them up,

- 1. pay a \$25 fine for the first offense
- 2. The second offense will result in a \$50 fin
- Three or more offenses will result in no return until June.

- Approval of schedule change request is dependent upon section capacities and course availability.

- Students are expected to purchase their materials from the PMA online bookstore to ensure they have the correct materials. Shopping on amazon and other external sources can result in buying resources that do not have the proper supplemental components such as activation codes.
- All materials listed under a given course are required, unless the term recommended is stated.
- The timeline for receipt of materials is based on the delivery option that you select.
- All materials are sent to the location you designate when completing the transaction (such as your home).
- Students should have their textbooks in possession by August 15th (there will be a small grace period after this date to have their books).

Google Classroom: Guardian Summaries

As a guardian, you can get email summaries about your student's activity in Classroom. Email summaries do not include grades. For grades check Powerschool.

In email summaries, you can review:

- Missing work—Work not turned in when the summary was sent.
- Upcoming work—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails)
 or that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails).
- Class activities—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers.

Google Classroom: Get Guardian Summaries

To get email summaries of your student's work, you must accept an email invitation from a teacher or administrator. You have 120 days to accept an invitation before it expires. You can unsubscribe from summaries or remove yourself as a guardian at any time.

- 1. The teacher or administrator emails you an invitation to join your student's class.
- 2. In your email program, open your email invitation.
- 3. Click **Accept**. If you're not the guardian, click **I'm Not The Guardian**.
- 4. Click **Accept** to confirm.

When you accept an invitation, you and your student get an email confirmation.
