## HUDSON

Hudson City Schools has a central pick-up in the morning at the Hudson Library, departing at 7:35-7:50 a.m. and at The Western Reserve Church on the south side of West Streetsboro Road (Rte. 303) at 7:54 a.m.

The afternoon bus leaves Old Trail at approximately 3:30 p.m. and stops at West Streetsboro Road (Rte. 303) at Heather Lane at approximately 3:50 p.m. The second stop is at The Western Reserve Church on West Streetsboro Road (Rte. 303) at approximately 3:51 pm. The last stop is at Veterans Way Community Park on Veterans Way at approximately 3:55 p.m. Drop-off will be at the entrance of the south side open community lot. Students are instructed to remain on the bus if they do not see an adult to receive them.

## REVERE

Revere Local Schools provides neighborhood busing as well as busing from Bath Elementary to Old Trail School ONLY on days when they are busing Revere's own students. On days when Revere schools are not in session and the neighborhood buses are NOT running, Revere will provide a shuttle bus From Bath Elementary School in the morning.

The bus will depart promptly at 8:15 a.m.. They will provide an afternoon shuttle bus from Old Trail to Bath Elementary school on these days as well (NOT Richfield Elementary). Parents MUST be at Bath Elementary when the bus arrives at 3:35 p.m. Students with absent parents will be returned to Old Trail School.

IMPORTANT! Please note the following:

- Please check [Revere's academic calendar](#) to make note of days when Revere will NOT be in session.
- Dismissal changes for days when Revere is NOT in session must be reported to [Nancy Stockwell](#) (ECP-Grade 2) and/or [Michelle Schaeffer](#) (Grade 3-8).
- Revere busing for the 2022-2023 school year begins August 25.
- You will also need to check [Revere's website](#) for neighborhood bus stop times.
- Your child and his or her teacher will need to know the letter of the bus they will be transferring to in the afternoon.

The neighborhood buses transport the children in the morning to Bath Elementary where the Old Trail students board a separate bus bringing them to OTS.

In the afternoon, a Revere bus takes the Old Trail students to Richfield Elementary where they switch to their neighborhood "letter" buses to be transported home. Please contact Justin Miller at Revere Transportation Department or Kathy Kiss with questions.
