

# *Players of the Week*

It's a brother act and it's all Marian Catholic when it comes to naming Players of the Week this time.

Grabbing the brass rings are the Klupchak siblings, Tom and his older brother Bob.

Both starred in the Spartans' 23-6 conquest of Joliet Central, a triumph which kept alive their hopes for the Illini-8 championship and a spot in the 4A state playoffs. Currently, Marian is tied at the top with Lockport and Joliet Catholic.

BOB CARRIED most of the backfield load Saturday, running 17 times and gaining 59 yards, with one of this runs going for a touchdown. The 5-9, 160-pound junior leads Marian in scoring, rushing and total carries.

Tom, 5-10, 150-pound senior, was given high marks by his coaches for both pass defense and stoppage of the run. Joliet Central completed only four of 12 passes for 48 yards and was limited to 18 yards rushing.

Junior fullback Mike Voldness scored four touchdowns, three on runs and one on a pass reception in the Homewood-Flossmoor rout of Bloom Trail, 36-0. He defensive counterpart was Fran Pellettiere, seven solo tackles and five assists. He also recovered a fumble and blocked a punt which led to a score.

Scott Smalley is Coach Dan DeCaprio's pick every week on defense. In the 20-12 Crete-Monee loss to Bradley, Smalley was credited with 15 tackles, plus four assists. On offense for the

Warriors, quarterback Keith Nuzzo completed 10 of 18 passes for 101 yards and both of his team's touchdowns.

RICH EAST coach Bob Lombardi nominated his offensive linemen, Tom Krolkowski, Alan Greenberg, Phil Grady, Mark Cimaroli and John Schohl. On defense, Lombardi selected Brian McMahon, three sacks and five unassisted tackles, plus seven assists, in a 27-18 victory at Kankakee Westview.

Scott McMullen, 5-9, 173-pound senior, was Coach Bill Sneddon's choice on defense at Rich Central after a 26-0 win over Bremen. McMullen had five tackles and three assists.

Sneddon named quarterback Jeff Jacobson on offense. While he completed just four of nine passes, Jacobson hit Don Passmore for two touchdowns and also passed to Doug Alleavitch for a two-point conversion.

Coach Dennis Harris at Bloom nominated Lance Cotton, defensive free safety, and Jerry Kwasek on offense. Rich South's nick Misch named Quarterback Steve Gilham on offense.
