

## Exemptions



- Students must maintain an 80 or above average.
- Students may not have more than two absences in the class they wish to exempt prior to the day of the exam(s).
- Assignment to an alternative education program (BIC or JJAEP), to an alternative placement class (AC or ISS) for disciplinary reasons, or any suspensions will negate any request for exam exemptions.
- Students may not have absence failed any class for the semester.



### ID CARD POLICY

- Students **MUST** wear a current ID at all times while on campus and while attending any school-related activity/function. Wearing an ID is a safety and security issue not a discipline issue. Students should be wearing a current year school-issued ID upon entry and teachers shall ensure that each student in his or her first class of the day is in ID compliance. If a student removes their ID they are to be assigned a referral for insubordination and are subject to disciplinary actions.
- All Mansfield ISD high school students will receive their first identification card free. and Replacement IDs may be purchased for \$5. The ID cards must include contact information for suicide prevention hotlines. The ID **MUST** be visible and worn on the front of the student's torso between the shoulder blades and the natural waistline. ID lanyards and/or clips are provided for a fee to students on each campus.
- Specific services/functions that shall be denied when a student is out of ID compliance: Saturday School; Detention Hall; computer lab usage; library entry; hall passes; phone privileges in offices; and parking stickers.


### Receiving your ID

- ID Cards will be issued beginning on the first day of school.
- Your social studies class will be called down to the library to receive an ID card at some point during the first 6 days of school.
- Once you receive an ID card, you will be responsible for wearing it every day while you are on campus.



### Dress Code Violation

- **All students must be in compliance with the district's dress code.**
- **Dress code violations will result in consequences and parent notification.**
- **Someone will need to bring you a change of clothing before you can attend class.**

Non-natural hair colors are allowed. Hair must be neat clean.

- Form fitting pants, such as leggings, jeggings, spandex and tights must be covered with a top reaching **NO HIGHER** than fingertip length.

## Attendance / Tardies



### Attendance / Tardies

- School begins each day at 7:25. Students are encouraged to arrive much earlier to ensure they are on time and ready for the school day.
- Cafeteria doors are opened each morning at 6:45 am.
- Students have a 5-minute passing period between classes.
- Each student can receive two tardy warnings before receiving tardy consequences.
- Students are authorized 4 absences per semester.
- Students will absence fail on the 5<sup>th</sup> absence.
- Excess tardies will result in disciplinary consequences.

Tardy count will start over at the beginning of each 6 weeks.

### New Tardy Policy

- First 2 tardies are warnings.
- You will receive consequences after your 2<sup>nd</sup> tardy. We will also contact your parents or guardians.

### Attendance / Absence Failure

- The state of Texas has mandated that each student will attend school / class at least 90 % of the time to receive credit.
- Students attendance is very important.
- If you miss school you might fall behind and you stand a chance of absence failing.
- Absence failing is missing more than 4 days in any class.
- Students if you absence fail a class; you will have to attend Saturday School to regain your credit for that failed class.

### VOE (Verification of Enrollment)

Students cannot absence fail any classes.  
(More than 4 absences)

Students will have to make up hours if they absence fail to get a VOE.

### Electronics

Cell phones, headphones and ear buds will be confiscated if students are caught using them in the classroom. Use cell phones in the cafeteria during your lunch period

### Food and Drinks

- Cups with a locking device are allowed in the classroom and hallway.
- No Whataburger, Chic-Fila, McDonalds, Burger King (cups) and etc..... Cups are not allowed in the hallways or classroom. Only in the Cafeteria.
- No Food in the classroom or hallway.
- You may eat your food in the cafeteria.
- Violators are subject to consequences

### Food and Drinks

- No Uber or other food deliveries



### Lunch / Leaving Campus

- Lunch is divided into 4 separate periods; A lunch, B lunch and C lunch and D lunch.
- Each lunch period is a total of 30 minutes long
- Students may use electronic devices during their lunch period
- Students may not leave campus during lunch: exceptions: Ben Barber and parent sign out
- Students who leave campus will be subject to school discipline.

### Student Problem Solving

- Students should talk to their teacher if they have an issue in the classroom.
- Always give the teacher a chance to deal with a classroom issue.
- Report serious issues to your teachers or assistant principal.
- Please allow your Legacy teachers and administrators to help you solve any problems you run into on campus.
