Financial Aid

- Due to availability of resources, it is to your advantage to apply as early as possible. Blackbaud Financial Aid Management applications open February 1, 2022. In order for an application to be considered, it must be verified through Blackbaud Financial Aid Management first. This can take time. Please submit your documentation in a timely manner.
- First round of consideration will begin March 1, 2022.
- Each family receiving financial aid will be required to volunteer a minimum of 30 verified hours throughout the school year.
