

Radnor Township School District

Property Tax or Rent Rebate Matching Program



The Radnor Township School District is pleased to announce a new program for taxpayers that will provide a matching property tax or rent rebate for eligible residents. The rebate will be provided for school property tax paid in the 2021 tax year (July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022).

The new program will provide additional rebates to any resident who applies and receives a property tax or rent rebate from the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue through their existing program.

Rebates are eligible for residents who are aged 65 or older, aged 50 or older and are a widow/widower, and permanently disabled persons aged 18 or older. Those who are eligible must also meet specific income requirements (income under \$35,000 for homeowners or under \$15,000 for renters).

NOTE: Applicants can exclude one-half of all Social Security income.

Application deadline: **JUNE 30, 2022**
Rebates begin: **EARLY JULY, 2022**
NOTE: The department may extend the application deadline if funds are available.

Rebates for eligible seniors, widows, widowers and people with disabilities.

To receive the Radnor Township SD rebate, you must take the following steps:

1. Apply for the PA Dept. of Revenue rebate and meet all eligibility requirements prior to December 31, 2022.

2. Upon receipt of PA Dept. of Revenue rebate, submit required documentation to the Radnor Township School District prior to June 30, 2023.

3. Receive rebate from Radnor Township School District.
