What is a SHAC?

The Lockhart ISD School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) works to foster a culture of health and wellness for students, families and staff. Members consist of LISD parents, school personnel and community members. The SHAC meets 5 times per year to review Lockhart ISD coordinated school health programs and make suggestions on ways to improve the health and wellness of our Lockhart ISD community.

What does the SHAC do?

The SHAC works to assist the District in ensuring that local community values are reflected in the District's coordinated school health programs. The SHAC makes recommendations to the District and to the Board of Trustees.

What is Included in a Coordinated School Health Program?

The components of a coordinated school health program include nutrition services, health services, counseling and social services, physical education, health education, family and community involvement, health promotion for staff, healthy school environment.
