Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA)

Annual Notification Letter

August 25, 2021

On December 14, 1987 the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) became effective, requiring the school district to inspect all buildings for friable and non-friable asbestos-containing materials and develop management plans which outline actions to be taken to control the release of asbestos fibers.

DaVinci Academy has been inspected by accredited asbestos inspectors. As a result of this inspection, we have compiled an asbestos management book for DaVinci Academy. As required by Federal and State regulation, DaVinci Academy has an Asbestos Management Plan on file and it is available for inspection by appointment in each of our three school buildings: the main office at 2033 Grant Avenue, main office at 215 E 22nd St, and 2221 Grant Ave. The school's certified Asbestos Management Planner is Fred Donaldson. Results of school asbestos inspection by accredited inspectors are available for public viewing in each DaVinci School or at the DaVinci School's District Office located at 2033 Grant Avenue in Ogden, Utah (801) 675-9538.

Asbestos re-inspections are done, as required by law, every three years with surveillance at six-month intervals.
