#### WHAT IS MTSS?

MTSS is a Multi-Tiered System of Supports to ensure that **all** students receive the support they need to make progress toward meeting grade-level standards and social emotional/behavioral expectations.

### WHAT ARE THE KEY COMPONENTS OF A MULTI-TIERED SYSTEM OF SUPPORTS?



Universal screening to identify students needing supplemental support



High-quality instruction in academics, social, emotional, and behavioral learning



Multiple tiers of academic, social, emotional, and behavioral support that are progressively more intensive



Evidence-based interventions matched to student need



Ongoing progress monitoring of student performance

System of Supports (MTSS).





WHAT ARE TIERED SUPPORTS?



Academic, social, emotional, and/or behavioral instruction that all students receive.

For students needing additional support beyond Tier 1 Instruction:



Moderately intensive support targeted toward a student's area of concern.



Highly intensive support targeted toward a student's specific skill deficit.

Students needing supplemental instruction/intervention to support their needs are monitored regularly to determine progress toward grade level academic, social, emotional, and/or behavioral expectations.

## HOW DOES THE SCHOOL IDENTIFY AND SUPPORT STUDENTS?

- ➤ During the school year, schools screen all students to see which students are meeting grade level standards and which students need additional academic support.
- ➤ Triangulated entry criteria are applied (e.g., grades, attendance, behavior, diagnostic/screener data, common assessments, etc.) to determine if an intervention is warranted.
- ➤ For the students needing more support, a school-based team plans interventions and identifies how progress will be determined and monitored (Tiers 2 and 3).



# WHAT CAN I EXPECT FROM MY CHILD'S SCHOOL?

- ➤ Information regarding my child's progress in meeting grade-level standards, social, emotional, and behavioral expectations;
- ➤ Notice of academic, social, emotional, and/or behavioral concerns (early identification);
- ➤ Instruction and intervention that is matched to my child's needs;
- ➤ Feedback on how my child is responding and making progress
