

# Madison County Driver's License Testing

**Location:** Court Annex Building – 135 West Irvine Street, Richmond, KY

**Testing Days:** Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday & Fridays

**Written Tests:** 12:30pm-3:30pm

**Road Tests:** 8:30am-11:00am (by appointment)

**Motorcycle Tests:** 2:00pm-3:40pm, 1st & 3rd Thursday of the Month  
(by appointment)

## Requirements for Obtaining a Permit / License

- An individual must be at least 16 years of age
- Must complete the required written, vision and skills tests administered by the Kentucky State Police before obtaining a permit/license
- If the applicant is under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian must sign the **Driver's License/Identification Card application form**
- If the applicant is under the age of 18, a School Compliance Verification form from the student's school district must be presented. **(See School Counselor)**
  - Must Be passing 4 out of 6 classes at semester
  - Can not have more than 8 unexcused absences per semester

*The school will send a report to the Kentucky Department of Education at the end of each semester. If the student does not meet Compliance Requirements, he or she will lose their license until the preceding semester the requirements are met. (Address Questions to the Counseling Office)*

## Documents Required:

- Valid Social Security card or W-2 form. (not laminated)
- Proof of identity, such as: Official Birth Certificate. Passport. Permanent Resident Card. *(No Photo Copies)*
- Proof of residency, such as: Recent utility bills. Property tax bill. Lease or rental agreement. Pay Slip.

*You must score at least 80% correct on your permit test in order to pass. That means you have to **answer** 24 out of 30 questions correct about the rules of the road and 8 out of 10 questions correct about road signs.*
