Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Notice

It may be necessary for the Keystone Central School District to use pesticides registered by the Environmental Protection Agency to manage a pest problem at a school building, on school grounds, or for an emergency pesticide application where pests pose an immediate threat to the health and safety of students and employees.

When an emergency application(s) is necessary the School District will notify by telephone any parent, guardian, or employee who requests such information by contacting the School District's IPM Coordinator, Robert Parcell, at 212 West Kyler Avenue, Mill Hall, PA 17751, or by email at *rpacella@kcsd.us*, or by phone at 570-893-4900, and asks to be placed on the Emergency Pest Application Call List.

Otherwise, use of the necessary applications will be made only when unauthorized persons do not have access to the area(s) being treated, and notices will be posted in the area(s) 72 hours prior to the application and for two days following the application.

Exemptions to this Notice include: disinfectants and antimicrobial products; self-contained baits in areas not accessible to students and gel-type baits places in cracks, crevices or voids; or swimming pool maintenance chemicals in the care and maintenance of a swimming pool.
