Lady Wildcats are Big Bend Conference Runner-Up Champions!

The Wakulla Middle Wildcats competed against the 6 other middles school in the Big Bend Conference on Thursday, April 7, at Wakulla High School.

For Middle School boys, the Wildcats placed 3rd overall.

“I can’t think of anything to say other than well done. Coming back from Spring Break it felt like we had lost our momentum, we had so many practices cancelled for weather and even had to post-pone another meet for a storm. I know our kids were worried about their performance, but this goes to show that when you keep working hard during the tough times, you will be successful. The meet’s top finishers are:

Aaron Anderson, 10th place in the 1600m.

Jordan Barnes placed 5th in the 200m Hurdles and 2nd in Triple Jump. His Triple Jump distance also was a qualifying score for the FLYRA State Championship, which is his second qualifying event for the year so a big congratulations goes to him for this achievement.

Triston Burnsed placed 9th in Discus and 15th in Shotput.

Colby Carranza placed 9th in Long Jump and has qualified for FLYRA State Championship.

Derek Davis placed 5th in Shotput and 6th in the 200m. He also qualifies for FLYRA State Championship as part of the boys 4 x 100m Relay team.

Dax Dichio came in 9th in the 800m, 4th in the 200m Hurdles, and 3rd in the Triple Jump. Dax has qualified for the FLYRA State Championship in the Triple Jump.

Chase Hall placed 9th in the High Jump and 7th in Triple Jump.

Wreynard Heath placed 10th in the 100m dash.

Brett McMillan placed 7th in the 200m Hurdles and 5th in Long Jump. Brett has qualified for the FLYRA State Championship as part of the boys 4 x 100m relay team.

Andrew Nelson placed 8th in the 200m, 2nd in the 200m Hurdles, 4th in High Jump, and 1st in the Long Jump. Andrew has qualified for the FLYRA State Championship in the High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump, and the 4 x 100m Relay team. Andrew has also set 3 school records this year with the boys 4x100m Relay team, High Jump, and Long Jump.

Adam Pfeifer placed 8th in the 1600m.

Aaron Pitts came in 9th in the 400m and 6th in High Jump.

Cole Randolph came 10th in the 400m and 7th in the 3200m.

David Whitaker placed 8th in the High Jump and 5th in the Triple Jump. David qualified for the FLYRA State Championship in the Triple Jump.

PJ Brazier came in 3rd in the 3200m.

Hadley Brown placed 9th in the 800m and 7th in the 1600m.

Makiya Cash came in 7th in the 100m and 8th in the Long Jump.

Makaylis Davis came in 8th in the 100m, 4th in the 200m Hurdles, 2nd in High Jump, and 5th in Long Jump.

Amariyah Donaldson placed 8th in the 200m Hurdles, 3rd in Long Jump, and 6th in Triple Jump.

Alexis Green placed 2 in the 200m Hurdles and 5th in Shotput.

Brooklynn Green placed 10th in the 200m, 6th in the 400m, and 5th in High Jump.

Arianna Manning placed 9th in the 100m and 6th in the 200m.

Emily Matson came in 9th in the 1600m.

Ember Odom place 9th in the Long Jump and 3rd in the Triple Jump. Ember has broken the Triple Jump record for Wakulla Middle School.

Rachaelei Porter placed 4th in the 400 and 7th in High Jump.

Heaven Taylor placed 9th and 10th in the Discus and Shotput, respectively.

London Waymon came in 5th in the 400m, and 7th in the Triple Jump.

Aliviah Whaley placed 8th in the 1600m.
