

Bylaw and Standing Rules changes 2022

Membership-Membership dues annual dues in the amount of \$5.00 changed to \$6.00 APPROVED

Nominations- APPROVED

- nomination committee shall be named at the February general meeting changed from March
- Nominations shall be announced at March general meeting changed from April
- Added: Only individuals who have served on a PTA board within Austintown School district for at least one year, may be considered for President or Treasurer.
- Officers are elected in April changed from May

Duties of board members

Removed from secretary APPROVED

- Submit to Ohio PTA the requested list of names and addresses of unit officers or chairs;
- Submit to Ohio PTA a record of annual volunteer hours of this PTA. Added them to president because they already do this

Treasurer APPROVED

- Have any disbursements signed by two officers added any disbursements to the sentence
- Shall not chair a committee
- Removed monthly payments of dues to Ohio pta because they don't get paid monthly anymore

Historian APPROVED

- Shall be chair of the yearbook committee and creating the yearly PTA sponsored yearbook

Duties of the board APPROVED

- Ensure a budget is prepared and submitted to the general association for approval for the fiscal year; changed to at the first meeting
- Board members must attend at least 50% of events held by this PTA in addition to their own committee commitments.
- Board members must attend board, regular and special meetings. If a board member cannot attend, they must notify the president. Two unexcused absences in a row may result in being dismissed from the board. Moved from section 7 to section 2 because it made more sense

Committees APPROVED

- Changed health, welfare and safety to health and safety
- Changed TEAM TIME to Staff Appreciation

Standing rules changes APPROVED

- A gift or money to a memorial fund not to exceed \$25 changed to \$50 shall be sent by the secretary to the principal, teachers, or staff in case of a death in their immediate family (parent, child, or spouse).
- In the event of a parent's death of an AES student, (\$25 will be deposited into their school lunch account.) \$50 will be donated to the family as deemed necessary by the board based on the needs of the family with help from school counselors and administration.

Added: This association may provide a \$250 scholarship to a graduating senior who meets the following criteria: APPROVED

- A. Is currently in good standing with the Fitch PTSA.
- B. Turns in the required essay
