Step 5: P	lacement Testing (for students entering 1 st - 8 th Grades)	
	TGS will schedule placement testing for admissions during the months of March through June.	
Step 6: Determination Letter (with tuition assistance award if applicable) After the interview, you will be notified of the admissions decision:		
Step 7: E	nrollment	
	The family of accepted applicant(s) <u>has two weeks from the date of the notification letter to respond</u> before the student's seat is offered to others.	
	Enrollment is completed online by submitting a signed enrollment contract, tuition contract, enrollment fee (non-refundable), and student record release authorization through your TADS account.	
Step 8: E	nrollment Paperwork:	
	All families will be required to complete the enrollment paperwork in order for students to begin classes.
