

Mustang High School
Personal Technology Device Policy

All cell phone/PTD practices at Mustang High School will follow Mustang Public School district policy #2140. All practices/policies apply to all students and to all non-school issued technology devices. PTDs include but are not limited to laptops, computers, tablets, cellular phones, smart phones, smart watches, ear pods, or headphones. Devices whose primary purpose is gaming and portable speakers are specifically prohibited at all times.

Cell phones/PTDs are allowed:

- During lunch, passing periods, and before/after school
 - To be used only by the student to whom it belongs.
- *Any of the above may be revised anytime at administration's discretion.*
**Cell phone/PTD use in any one instance does not grant permission for other situations.*

Cell phones/PTDs are NOT allowed (must be off and inside backpack):

- In the classroom.
- To be used to photograph or record another student or staff member without permission (includes buses).
- In any manner that causes a disruption to the school day for any student or staff member.
- To access inappropriate material while on school property
- To be used to bully, harass, threaten, intimidate, or otherwise tease another student.

Standard consequences of violation of school cell phone/PTD policy (actual consequences may vary due to severity of the violation):

- 1st violation:* Teacher issues a WARNING
2nd violation: Teacher issues WARNING, ASSIGNS DETENTION, NOTIFIES PARENT
3rd violation: STUDENT REFERRED TO OFFICE, PARENT MUST PICK-UP DEVICE
4th violation: PARENT PICK-UP DEVICE AND ISI 3 DAYS
5th violation: PARENT PICK-UP DEVICE, ISI 5 DAYS, AND LOSS OF PTD PRIVILEGE
SUBSEQUENT INFRACTIONS WILL RESULT IN OUT OF SCHOOL SUSPENSION.

**These consequences apply to the incidents per student and not incidents per PTD.*

Possession of a cell phone/PTD on school campus is a privilege, and may be revoked at any time by the administration for violating this school policy regarding such possession. Furthermore, I understand that the school and its employees are in no way responsible for any theft or damage of my cell phone/PTD while on school grounds. The school is not obligated to investigate the loss or damage of any cell phone/PTD.
