



Rx for Discovery Reading

The King's Academy offers ***Rx for Discovery Reading*** to strengthen the reading skills of our students. The ***Rx for Discovery Reading*** program offers small group supplemental reading instruction at a reasonable cost.

Who is eligible to enroll in the program?

Eligibility for this program is based on teacher recommendations, entrance testing results, and achievement test results. Students meet in small groups 2 days per week for 30-45 minutes during the school day. This instruction is supplemental to the reading curriculum being covered in the classroom.

How is this program different from the classroom curriculum?

Rx for Discovery Reading provides explicit and systematic, small group reading instruction that includes activities for phonological processing, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension development. A multi-sensory Orton-Gillingham based approach is used to teach reading skills. It is a key word approach to the learning of phonemes which integrates the concept that sounds, the building blocks of language, can be separated and used repeatedly in the process of reading and spelling.

How is progress assessed?

Students are given the KTEA Achievement test prior to starting the program and again in the spring to chart progress.

There is an additional fee for this program. This fee is in addition to regular tuition payments. If enrollment occurs during the school year, the cost will be pro-rated according to the same schedule on the tuition contract.
