Drug and Alcohol Testing for School Bus and Commercial Vehicle Drivers

The District shall adhere to State and federal law and regulations requiring a drug and alcohol testing program for school bus and commercial vehicle drivers.

This program shall comply with the requirements of the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 49 §382 et seq. The Superintendent or designee shall adopt and enact regulations consistent with State and federal law and regulations, defining the circumstances and procedures for testing.
