If you need child care for siblings during your ECFE class, please request at the time of registration. Children not registered will be accepted on a space available basis.

• ECFE offers a variety of classes for parents and children to come together to connect as a family, to discuss topics related to your child's stage of development, and to meet other families. Classes are available for infant, toddler, and preschool age children.

• Classes usually meet once a week (1- 1.5 hours) for eight to twelve weeks each trimester (Fall trimester is 10 weeks). Each session brings new opportunities to reflect on your child's stage of development, meet new families, and engage in discussions related to new parenting topics.

• A typical ECFE class begins with "parent-child time" where parents and children participate in fun learning activities together. While parents later join a parenting discussion facilitated by a parent educator, children continue their play with their early childhood teacher in the children's classroom. Families join together for songs and finger-plays during the closing circle time led by staff.

• Quality educational childcare is available for siblings not enrolled in classes. Owatonna ECFE operates based on a sliding fee scale; no one is turned away for inability to pay.

Come and go to meet your schedule.

Mixed Preschoolers 31+ MONTHS TO "NOT YET IN KINDERGARTEN"

Every member of a family brings unique strengths that help build and strengthen the family unit. Intentional parents notice and support each family member's efforts to grow and develop all aspects of the individual; cognitive, physical, emotional, social, moral, and spiritual.

- Parents will learn how to be intentional in their everyday interaction with their children.
- Content of the class will be parent driven to support the parenting journey.
- Come share your ideas and strategies to see each member of your family uniquely and help them develop into strong, healthy members of your family and your community.
- A child/parent experience with an early childhood educator begins the first 20 minutes of class before separating for parent discussion.

Playful Preschoolers 36 MONTHS TO "NOT YET IN KINDERGARTEN"

These combined-age preschooler classes provide families with current information about the important role of play for growing healthy preschoolers. Play teaches a child how the world works, and gives practice in independent thinking skills helpful in their school years.

- Children will experience the new "Read, Play, Learn" Curriculum, designed to provide rich literature and vocabulary that allows children to use their imagination and creativity to use play to fully "live the story" and practice new vocabulary.
- During parent time this class will focus on the social, emotional and language development necessary for strengthening relationships in families and for school readiness.

Preschool Experience (Ages 3-5) child-only classes

Families who enroll in identified parent/child classes, have the opportunity to provide their child with an additional early learning experience designed for the child-only. Children will learn through play and an introduction to preschool routines and structure.

- To be eligible for enrollment in Friday Child Only Classes, families must be enrolled in an additional parent/child class.
- Tuition will be \$35 for the Trimester.
- This is in addition to the tuition paid for the parent/child class. There is no sliding fee.
- Children need to be toilet trained, or a teacher may call to have you come assist your child.
- Registration will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Early Childhood Screening FOR 3 AND 4 YEAR-OLDS

Early childhood screening is a quick and simple check of how your child is learning and growing. It identifies possible health or learning concerns so children can get help before starting school.

Is there a charge? IT'S FREE – all children must participate in order to start Kindergarten in a Minnesota Public School.

When should I schedule an appointment for Early Childhood Screening? Earlier is better! Waiting until your child is about to start kindergarten is too late! The purpose of Early Childhood Screening is to identify children who may need additional time and experiences to be ready for school. The sooner we get started, the more likely your child will begin school with the necessary skills to succeed. Call us when your child turns 3.

 - Monday, Wednesday, Friday 8:00 10:00
- 'Lil Learners' is run through our ECFE program and offers a sliding fee schedule to families.

Why Preschool?

- All classes are taught by licensed early childhood educators.
- Bright Beginnings: Fountas & Pinnell curriculum builds literacy skills that align with Kindergarten.
- 'Lil Learners: Read, Play, learn curriculum builds children's literacy, language and social skills.
- Social & Emotional skill building.
- Exploration & discovery.
- Building independence & self help skills.
- Opportunities to engage in parent-child activities.

Transportation

- Bright Beginnings: Free transportation to and from preschool is available if your house is more than one mile from the school site.
- Less than a mile or 'Lil Learners: If you live within one mile of the school your child will attend, you can apply for the SMART transit bus. This option will transport them one-way, either to school or home from school. Rides will cost \$1.00 per ride. Scholarships are available.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Change your mind?** Please let us know as soon as possible if you decide not to take a class so that we can accommodate other families.
- A current **immunization** record is required for each child. Bring current immunization information with you at the time of registration or to your first class.
- **Full payment** for all classes is required at registration. Checks are payable to: Owatonna Community Education (Mastercard, Visa, American Express and Discover are also taken) **See Fee Structure below.*

ECFE Parent/Child Class Fee Structure

The class fee is based on your household's total yearly income, before taxes. The class fee selected by your family is confidential. Class fees are necessary to supplement state and local tax dollars dedicated to supporting early childhood programming. A trimester runs 8-12 weeks long depending on the ECFE calendar.

Your household's total yearly income, before taxes:

| Less than \$19,999 per yr | \$10.00 per class trimester |

Sibcare — \$5.00/trimester/family (non-refundable) Non-School District Resident Fee — \$10.00 additional per class

*Families with SCHA Health policies may qualify for class reimbursement. Please notify the front office with your SCHA number once you register!

Immunization Law Minnesota law (statute 121A.15) requires children enrolling in early education programs to show they have received immunizations or that they are a conscientious objector. The Owatonna ECFE program will require an immunization on file for every child that is enrolled. Please drop off or send a current immunization to Roosevelt Community School before classes begin or bring immunization records with you to the first day of class. Thank you.

Sib Care

- Sib Care is quality, on-site childcare for siblings' age birth to 9-years-old.
- Sib Care costs \$5 per family, per trimester.
- Service must be pre-registered and paid before the trimester starts.
- Service is limited due to size of classroom and available staffing.
- Absences from Sib Care can be called into the ECFE Attendance Line: 444-7937 The ECFE Attendance Line is a 24-hour voice messaging system.
- Sib Care is available for all classes unless noted.
