JHCD MEDICATION/PHYSICIAN-PRESCRIBED SERVICES

The Board of Education recognizes the need of some students to receive medications or physician-prescribed services during the school day when arrangements to receive those services outside of the school day are not in the best interest of the student.

Parents of students requiring medications or physician-prescribed services at school shall inform school personnel of the needs of the student. Parents shall be responsible for providing the appropriate forms, equipment, and supplies necessary for the administration of medications or physician-prescribed services. The administration of medications or physician-prescribed services will be provided by the school nurse or by trained personnel assigned by the principal and approved by the school nurse.

The Board of Education maintains the right to refuse to provide medications or physician-prescribed services when it is not in the best interest of the District.
