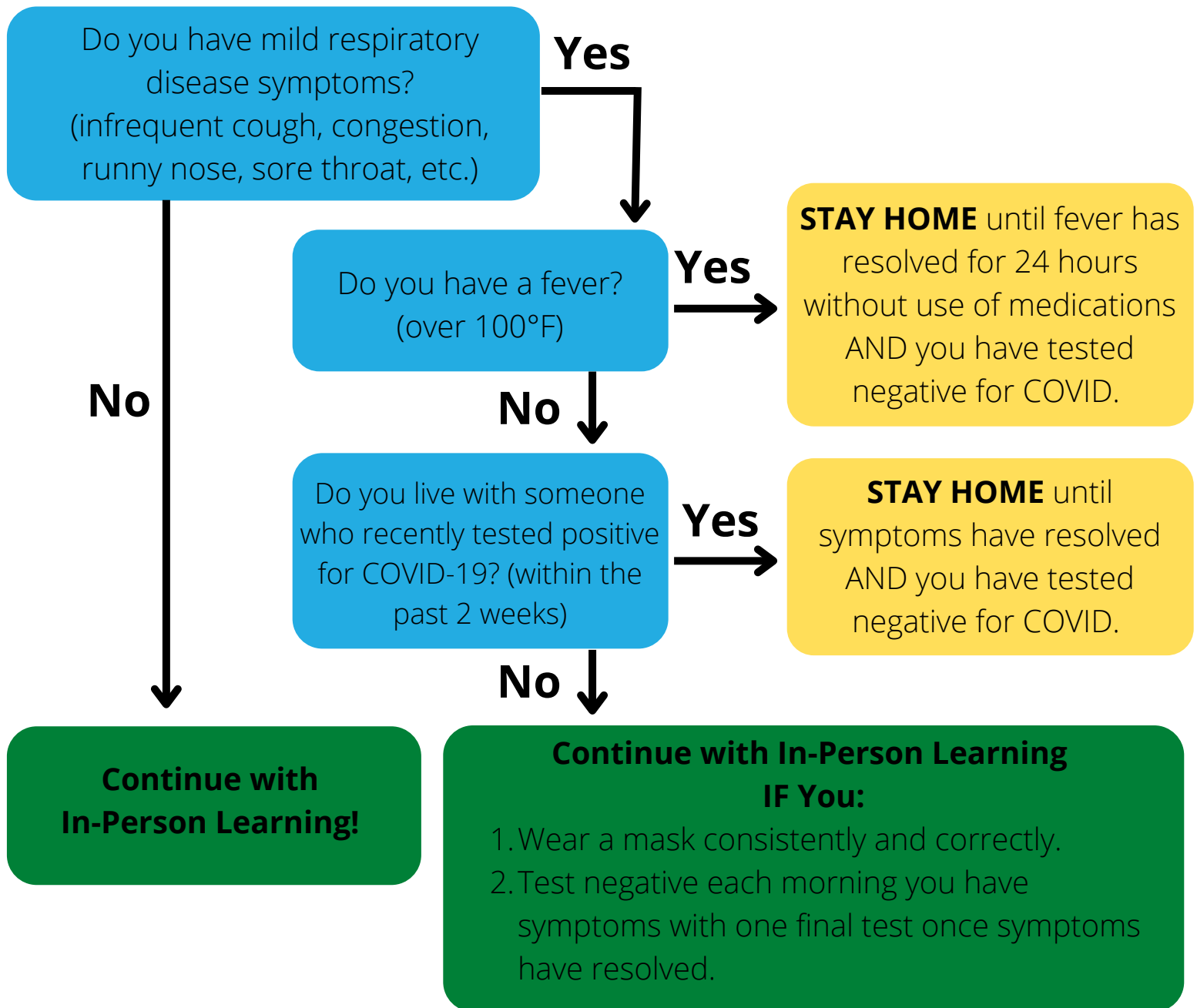


COVID-19 Symptoms Decision Tree*

As we transition to balancing respiratory illness prevention with maximizing in-person learning, school nurses and facility administrators continue to use their judgement to make the final decision on whether a student can remain in school.
