Transcripts

- Fill out a Transcript Request Form. The form must be submitted **at least 5 school days** before the deadline.
- Request forms can be downloaded from website or picked up in the School Counseling Office.
- There is a \$2 fee per transcript.
 - Electronic & Scholarship transcripts are free.
- Students must download forms (college, military, scholarships, tech schools, NCAA, etc.) and attach the forms to the transcript request form.



E-mails referring to these sources are not accepted.

Letters of Recommendations

- Use Transcript Request Form
- Complete the Senior Information Survey and give it to counselor with a copy of their resume
 - Documents must be submitted at least 10 school days before the deadline.
- Letters of recommendation will be mailed or electronically sent to the requesting institution or agency
- Documents can be picked up in the School Counseling Office



Meet ALL Graduation Requirements!

- To graduate, seniors must earn passing <u>final grades</u> in courses needed to fulfill the state requirements for graduation.
- The Student Service Learning (SSL) project must be completed. Mr. Mouli, in room 234 is our school point of contact.
- Your child must meet ALL state testing requirements.
- Counselors will conduct individual sessions with all seniors to ensure requirements are met by the end of the year.
- If you have any questions about your student's standing with graduation requirements do not wait! Please contact the school counselor as soon as possible.

Graduation Attire

Young men

White dress shirts, navy blue or black neckties, navy or black slacks (no denim), dark socks, and black shoes (no sport shoes). All belts must have a standard buckle. Small stud earrings only and necklaces with large pendants are prohibited.

Young ladies

Dress or skirt set, (no sport shoes; flat soles).
Shoes should have a strap (for safety reasons). Dresses should be no longer than mid-calf and must not hang below graduation gown. A skirt and a blouse count as a dress. Small stud earrings only and necklaces with large pendants are prohibited.



A request for any exemptions from the above requirements may be made by an individual student and must be submitted in writing to the principal by the end of the school day on March 31st. The written request must include a justification for the exemption and a detailed description of the attire that the student is seeking to wear.
