**END-OF-THE-YEAR PERFORMANCE
Saturday, May 13, 2023**

The non-refundable, end-of-the-year costume/recital fee includes custom-ordered costumes, a recording of the recital (link or USB), and costs associated with recital production. Also included is sound and light technicians, additional supervisory staff and any set, prop or miscellaneous expenses involved in presenting the recital.

Costuming must be ordered months in advance and only those students who have paid the fee will have costumes ordered. If a dancer withdraws after the order has been placed, any remaining balances must be paid. The costumes can be picked up after the performance.
