


BENEFACTORS CIRCLE \$10,000 and above (or \$833.33+/month)

ABOUT JESSE LONG

Jesse Long served as Greater Atlanta Christian School's co-founder and first President. In 1963, he committed to raising the funding required to open a hoped-for Christian school in Atlanta. God blessed the efforts of Mr. Long and a devoted group of leaders, enabling them to raise \$400,000 from 1,400 families. In 1967, they broke ground on a piece of property in rural Atlanta for a new Christian school. Jesse called it "God's school." Jesse Long served GAC for 38 years as President, becoming Chancellor in 1998. The Jesse Long Society, established in 2009, honors his tireless and longstanding commitment to our school.
