ISEE Testing

WHAT IS THE ISEE?

The ISEE (Independent Schools Entrance Exam) is an admissions test used by many private schools in North America. The ISEE provides a standard assessment of each applicant's skills as well as ranking of abilities and achievements compared to other applicants to the same grade. Park Tudor requires applicants to grades 4–10 to take the ISEE.

*Students applying to grades 10-11 can use PSAT scores in place of the ISEE. **If a student has taken ERB's in the past year, those scores can be used in place of the ISEE.

ARE THE HSPT AND THE ISEE THE SAME?

The ISEE and the HSPT are not the same test. The ISEE is a common entrance exam used by many private/independent schools. The HSPT is a common entrance exam used by many Catholic high schools. The HSPT cannot be used in place of the ISEE.

ISEE LEVELS

ISEE Primary Level: Applicants to Grade 4 ISEE Lower Level: Applicants to Grade 5 and Grade 6 ISEE Middle Level: Applicants to Grade 7 and Grade 8 ISEE Upper Level: Applicants to Grades 9–12

WHAT ARE THE DIFFERENT SECTIONS OF THE ISEE?

The Primary Level contains two sections: Reading and Math.

The Lower, Middle and Upper Levels contain five sections: Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning, Reading Comprehension, Mathematics Achievement and an Essay. The first four sections are all multiple-choice questions.

SHOULD MY CHILD PREPARE FOR THE ISEE AND TAKE A TEST PREP COURSE?

At Park Tudor, we recommend that applicants do not spend a great deal of time preparing for the ISEE. We want the test scores to be indicative of a child's true academic abilities and not an indication of their test prep skills. We do recommend an applicant familiarize himself/herself with the format of each of the test sections and possibly complete a few practice questions for each section. (Once you've registered for the ISEE, you will receive access to a free test prep guide.)

INTERPRETING YOUR CHILD'S TEST RESULTS

When reviewing an applicant's test scores, our team focuses on the Stanine score for each subtest, which ranges from 1–9. Generally speaking, Stanines of 1–3 are below grade level, Stanines of 4–6 are on grade level, and Stanines of 7–9 are above grade level. Park Tudor does not require a specific score for each section; the ISEE results are one data point we use when considering a student's fit for Park Tudor.
