GRACE AND PERSEVERANCE



The last 15 months have brought many challenges, globally and locally, which provoked us to do some soul searching and truth-seeking. As a faith and learning community, we endured and maintained a humble and grateful disposition throughout it all.

Our community continued to provide time, talent, and treasure in various ways to help Vancouver College be an exceptional school.

We are grateful to our excellent and dedicated educators who committed themselves during these challenging times by enabling each boy to develop and grow into a better man. Our teachers were led by our exceptional Assistant Principals, Barbara Seppelt, John Paul Cavalluzzo, and Frank Trentadue, all under the energetic and servant leadership of our Principal, Daryl Weaver.

We are incredibly proud of the Class of 2021, who despite so much adversity continued to demonstrate resilience with grace and perseverance. Many students received university acceptances, scholarship offers, and finished with provincial honours. We celebrated the 2021 graduating class with pomp and circumstance that included a special barbecue on campus and a "Grad Springfest" in lieu of the formal Dinner Dance. Our 155 grads received a meal to share with their families personally delivered by a VC teacher or staff to their homes. The festivities continued with 11 modified Commencement Exercises and Graduation Liturgy to celebrate this milestone.

Throughout the school year, our boys found virtual ways to follow the charism of Blessed Edmund Rice by standing in solidarity with those marginalized by poverty and injustice locally (downtown Vancouver) and globally (Brownsville, Texas; the Bronx, New York; and Lima, Peru). Our Campus Ministry team also found ways to deliver our retreat program. This program continues to be a pillar of strength for our students' spiritual, social, and emotional development.

We are fortunate to be able to work alongside all of our

parents, the primary educators of our students. Despite restrictions due to the pandemic, the Vancouver College Parents Association Executives found ways for our parent community to grow even stronger through re-imagined initiatives and events. Their continuous support is greatly appreciated and means a lot to our boys.

In October 2020, we blessed and dedicated the new Lannon Hall and spent the school year enjoying our new spaces, including our new Elementary school and Blessed Edmund Rice Chapel. The dedicated sacred space unites our community even more and strengthens our bonds through reflection, liturgy, and prayer.

The new buildings totalling 88,000 square feet are now complete. The massive undertaking of Manrell Hall and the new Lannon Hall would not have been possible without funding from the remarkably successful Our Next Century Campaign. We are grateful for our community's generous financial support. As the chapter of Our Next Century Campaign comes to a close, we will continue to work hard to raise funds to manage our construction debt and to fund other capital renewal projects to meet our school's future needs. 
2020-2021 FINANCIAL REPORT

Sources of Funds

In 2020-2021, funding from all sources totaled \$14.30 million, an increase of \$750,000 from the previous year. Tuition increased \$375 per student with the addition of technology for students, and Government Funding increased 2.77%. Other sources of funds include donations from Vancouver College Millennium Foundation (VCMF), VC Parents Association, and Walkathon. The Board continued to support the Blessed Edmund Rice Bursary Program by providing \$407,893 in tuition funding to help families in need of financial assistance in the 2020-21 school year.




Expenditures

On the expenditures side, Vancouver College spent \$13.01 million to operate the school and invested \$1.29 million in capital expenditures for school operations. The main expenditures for operating the school are salaries and benefits, but also include expenditures on Academics, Administration, Maintenance, and the required mortgage principal and interest payments. Capital expenditures were mainly computers for students with the inaugural one-to-one chromebooks beginning with Grades 7, 8 and 10, as well as continued upgrades of audio-visual equipment and furniture for classrooms.


As of June 30, 2021 only \$11 million had to be borrowed to complete construction of Phase 1a (Manrell Hall) and Phase 1b (Lannon Hall) of our Campus Redevelopment as a significant portion of the project cost was funded through donations raised from the *Our Next Century* Campaign. This loan covers the difference between the total construction cost (\$43 million) and funds raised (\$40 million) and as bridge financing due to the timing of multi-year gifts. This debt will be serviced by the school and from future donations to VCMF from the Vancouver College community.

IN GRATITUDE **PRO OPERIS AWARD**

In June 2021, the Vancouver College Board of Directors had an intimate gathering and presented its prestigious Pro Operis Award to three recipients. The Pro Operis Award is the Board's only award given to acknowledge recipients' extraordinary generosity and dedicated service to the Catholic Education of youth. It is a recognition of the honorees' contributions to the charism of Blessed Edmund Rice and for advancing the mission of the school. The 2021 Pro Operis Award was presented to Mark Brown, Rebecca Grinti-Sherry and Chris Sherry.

Rebecca Grinti-Sherry and Chris Sherry joined Vancouver College in the fall of 2012. It did not take long for both of them immerse themselves in the community. They attended numerous events such as the Finnegan



Ball, Lunar New Year dinner, and different athletic events. Rebecca was also one of the long-time lead volunteers for the Mother's Christmas Tea.

Their commitment and love for the school were further demonstrated in December 2015 when they accepted the call to be Co-Chairs of the Our Next Century Campaign. They created a strong momentum early in the campaign with their transformational gift, thus giving the Board further confidence and assurance that the Our Next Century Campaign would be successful. The Sherrys understand the heart of Vancouver College. And because of their generosity, faith, and commitment to the mission of Vancouver College, we will look forward to seeing generations of boys who will leave Vancouver College as better men.



Mark Brown has served as a member of the Board of Directors for Vancouver College Limited for eight years from 2013 to 2021. Mark has deep ties with Vancouver College as he first walked the school's halls in 1974 as a grade one student, and his father, John (VC 1950). and two sons (Scott VC



2020 and Matthew VC 2021) are alumni of the school as well. In addition, Mark's mother, Janet, was one of the first women on the Vancouver College Board and served as Chair from 1990 to 1992.

We are grateful for everyone's gifts of time, talent, and treasure.

This year, I look back with humble gratitude and a sense of nostalgia because the Our Next Century Campaign came to a close at the end of the 2020-21 school year. It is hard to believe how far we have come and how much we have accomplished through this ambitious campaign. We are grateful to past and present visionaries, educational leaders, and Board members who dared to dream. We are grateful to our leadership benefactors whose names are visible throughout our campus as our way of acknowledging their generosity.
