PICTURE DAY DETAILS

- · You may wear a mask in your photo if you are more comfortable doing so.
- Sunglasses, hats and hoods are not allowed in photos. Religious head coverings may be worn.
- -Portraits will be used in the 2023 yearbook and for student ID cards. If you miss picture day, you will need to get an ID from the office.

Retakes and last chance photos for all grade levels will be Wednesday, Oct. 19.

MESSAGE FROM FOOD SERVICE

We want all of our students at SM West to be able to eat a good breakfast and lunch. Please read the information below from Food Services. Students are free to bring a sack lunch to school, but no fast food items should be brought into the building. SM West does not have an open lunch policy except for Seniors



whose parents have completed the permission form link. (An email was sent to all senior parents from Jennifer Silverstein with the link). Open Lunch for seniors will not begin until after ID cards have been distributed. Tentatively after Spring Break.

22 - 23 School Meals

Food Service will continue to offer healthy and appealing breakfast and lunch options for all students this school year. Unfortunately, the USDA nationwide waivers allowing for free school meals for all students concluded with the end of the 2021 - 22 school year.

The meal prices of 2022 - 23 are below . Breakfast at the High School \$1.65 Lunch at the High School \$3.00

Families will be able to complete a child nutrition meal benefit application to see if they qualify for free or reduced priced meals. The information and link regarding the meal benefit application will be a part of the parent online verification process as well as be available on the <u>Food Service web</u>.

Families are encouraged to check their student's current food service account balance on School Café - https://www.schoolcafe.com/SHAWNEEMISSION. Payments to a student's food service account can be done by check or cash at the school, credit card online through e Funds (\$3 fee) or by calling the Food Service office 993-9710 (no fee). Student account balances (positive or negative) do roll over to the next year – even if the student switches schools within the district.

Food Service will continue to follow the procedure of serving students a full breakfast or a full lunch regardless of the money they have in their account. During the 2022 - 23 school year, when a student's account is low or in the negative, notifications will be made to parents. When an account is - \$75.00, the parent/guardian will receive a notification that if the account is not paid it will be turned over to the collection agency. Students will not be permitted to purchase ala carte items if their account is negative.


PARKING PERMITS

Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors are able to park on campus at SM West. A parking permit must be purchased and a parking sticker picked up from our Security personnel in the front entrance.

Parking is \$55 for the year.

It is extremely important that students only park in assigned areas for students, and not staff parking. Tickets will be assessed by our security staff. All rules and regulations are listed with the parking application. See the PDF below. Also included is a map of West parking.

Students are excluded from parking in the staff spaces.





Shawnee Mission West recognizes academic excellence by placing students on one of two honor rolls: a 3.0 Honor Roll or a Principal's Honor Roll.


To be named to the 3.0 Honor Roll, a student must have a GPA (grade point average) of 3.0 for a minimum of 2.5 credits per semester. The grades of "A", "B", "C", "D" and "F" will be used to calculate the GPA. Grades of "Q", "P", "E", "K", "NG", "WP" or "WF" are not used in the GPA computation formula. A grade of "N", "D", "F", or "I" will eliminate the student from being named to the Honor Roll.

To be named to the Principal's Honor Roll, a student must have a GPA of 4.0 or above and be enrolled in a minimum of 2.5 credits per semester. The grades of "A", "B", "C", "D", and "F" will be used to calculate the GPA. Grades of "Q", "P", "E", "K", "NG", "WP" or "WF" are not used in the GPA computation formula. A grade of "N", "D", "F", or "I" will eliminate the student from being named to the Honor Roll.

Congratulations to all of our students who worked hard and gave their best efforts towards their academic excellence.


