

S.I.S. is home to the Spartan Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society. NJHS is an organization of leadership-minded students committed to helping the school and community through various service projects. Our NJHS students have been involved in conducting campus improvements, cleanups of the local park, and holding fundraisers for numerous charities. They are also responsible for planning and hosting the 8th grade social event of the year, the “Frosty Frolic” dance.

NJHS membership is open to students who have been at Seabrook for at least one semester and who are now entering the 7th or 8th grade. They must maintain a cumulative grade point average (a combination of all classes, all semesters) of at least 92, and can receive no more than one N (and no U’s) on each report card.

Meetings are generally the first Monday of every month, during advisory time.

We select new members in late September. Anyone that wishes to be considered for membership needs to complete an information form showing their commitment to the NJHS ideals of scholarship, leadership, service, citizenship, and character.
