HOW TO PUT MONEY ON YOUR CHILD'S ACCOUNT

There are 2 ways to put money on your child's lunch account

- Send cash or check with them to school and they can deposit it when they go to purchase lunch or snacks in the cafeteria.
- Go on the Parent Portal and pay with a credit card

To prepay on your students lunch account, click HERE.

- If your student qualifies for free or reduced meals, they can still receive them this school year, but you must take action to make it happen by completing an application.
 - To complete the Online Free/Reduced lunch application, parents/guardians can login to <u>ParentPortal</u> and complete the application. Click on your child's name, then click "Food Service Free & Reduced Lunch Application" under School Links.
 - Paper applications are also available. Click <u>HERE</u> to download and follow the instructions on the application.

- Elementary \$3.40/\$.40 reduced eligible
- Middle School \$3.90/\$.40 reduced eligible
 - HS \$3.90-\$4.25/\$.40 reduced eligible

PLEASE HELP YOU CHILD MEMORIZE THEIR STUDENT ID OR BRING THEIR ID INTO THE CAFETERIA WITH THEM! IT MAKES THE TRANSACTION GO MUCH QUICKER THAN LOOKING THEM UP BY NAME!

All schools will be offering ala carte options. Elementary will have minimal choices while the HS's will have an extensive ala carte menu. Ala carte purchases do not count towards free lunch.

Free or reduced price lunches MUST include at least 3 out of the 5 food groups offered: Milk, Grains, Protein, Fruits and Vegetables and at least one of these foods must be a fruit or vegetable. Although only 3 items are required, the student may take all 5 if they choose to do so.

VERY IMPORTANT NOTICE: The free school lunch program that applied to ALL students last year has ended. Click HERE for a letter of explanation. Students may still purchase lunch in the cafeteria.
