

DeWitt Perry MS Orchestra Activity Fee (2022-2023)

The DWP Orchestra Activity fee for the 2022-2023 school year consists of a one time fee for all students. This fee helps cover the cost of activities/events/expenses for the Orchestra program and your student specifically. Examples include: Student Orchestra T-shirt, entry fees for Solo/Ensemble contest and Spring music festivals, guest clinicians, purchase of equipment, and others.

Step 1 - Indicate which group your student is (this is their Orchestra activity fee)

- Symphonic (\$80)

Step 2 - If your student is using a “school-issued” instrument, an additional (\$60) is required for maintenance of instrument (strings, bow rehairs, and end of year repairs)

- School Instrument
- Rental/Own Instrument

Step 3 - Uniform Fee (\$10)

Philharmonic/Symphonic Ladies - Concert Uniform dry cleaning fee
