School nurse register and update vaccination records, please inform your school nurse if your child is vaccinated outside the school in following school years.

If your child gets any vaccine in another country please provide a copy of the vaccination records to the school.

## Relevant information

Information about students between 12 and 16 years old shall not be given to the parents/guardians when the child, for reasons that should be respected, does not want this.

Information that is necessary to fulfill parental responsibility must nevertheless be given to parents/guardians.

## School Nurse Duties in Middel Years Programmes

### MYP1

HPV(Human papillomavirus) vaccine are offered to those students born in **2010**. There are 2 doses with 6 months in between.

Parents will be informed about vaccination date.

### MYP2

Height and weight measurements are offered. The students are asked to fill in a questionnaire about their weill.being. I visit the class and discuss on topics such as:

what influences the physical and psychosocial class environment?

healthy living and achieving balance in everyday life

Sexuality, violence and the consequences on people's

What influences our health?

### MYP3

I visit the class and talk sexual health, sexuality, sexually transmitted diseases and contraception.
