ACCREDITATION

Jupiter Christian School was founded in 1963 and is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Council on Accreditation and School Improvement (SACS CASI) and the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). The school features a strong academic program within a Christ-centered curriculum. JCS provides opportunities for its students through fine arts, athletics, clubs and organizations.

ATHLETICS AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Jupiter Christian School is a member of the Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA). Jupiter Christian's athletic program includes opportunities for both Middle School and JV/Varsity level teams and features basketball, baseball, cheerleading, cross-country, football, golf, lacrosse, track & field, volleyball, beach volleyball, softball, swimming, and wrestling. Additional opportunities for involvement include community service, Bible studies, mission trips, academic and fine arts clubs, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, National Honor Society, National Art Honors Society, Tri-M Music Honors Society, and Student Government Association, and more.

COLLEGE & GUIDANCE COUNSELING

The Guidance Office seeks to offer academic, social and emotional support to our student body to ensure success at JCS and beyond. Guidance leads all academic testing including SAT, PSAT, AP, ACT Aspire and more. Experienced counselors not only help students navigate unique career and personality strengths to identify career and calling, but provide insight into the college admissions process by providing workshops, presentations, group sessions and individual meetings to create strategic plans to support college acceptance and scholarship opportunities.

DUAL ENROLLMENT AND ADVANCED PLACEMENT CLASSES

JCS has established a partnership with Palm Beach Atlantic University which allows students to enroll in college coursework while on the Jupiter Christian campus. These classes will be offered in conjunction with their traditional curriculum. Students must hold a 3.0 cumulative GPA and have completed their sophomore year to participate. In addition to DE, JCS offers 12 Advanced Placement courses in English, History, Math, Science, Fine Arts, and Computer Science.

MINIMESTER

Every year our High School students participate in intensive, hands-on, applied learning activities with faculty as an extension of Jupiter Christian's academic and service goals. These Minimester experiences are offered locally, nationally, and internationally and encompass themes such as STEM, history, service, college tours, and more.

HONORS PROGRAM AND ACADEMIC RECOGNITION

The Honors Program diploma requires 10 credits in courses that are Honors, Advanced Placement, or Dual Enrollment. To receive an honors diploma, the student must have a 3.5 weighted GPA.

Jupiter Christian School has two honor distinctions based on all credit courses for each semester.

Principal's List: Students receiving all A's and a 4.0 or higher for the grading period.

Honor Roll: Students receiving all A's or B's and a 3.5 or higher for the grading period.
