2022-2023 SLU ACC Grading Scales:

SLU grading scales in each individual academic department may differ. Please check with you son's class instructor for detailed grading scale information.

SLU ACC Student Eligibility:

HS students may elect to register for up to 11 advanced college credits per semester. Students are encouraged to seek counsel and guidance in choosing dual-credit courses.

In order to be eligible for dual credit courses, participating students are required to be in full compliance with the MDHE - Missouri Department of Higher Education following requirements:

- a) Juniors and seniors must have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale and electronic approval of the 1818 course instructor or 1818 Partner Coordinator
- b) Sophomores are eligible to enroll in 1818 courses in certain circumstances, to include sequenced 1818 courses in Language courses numbered 1010 or above. Sophomores may be approved by 1818 Partners to enroll if the students have
 - a minimum 3.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale and
 - completed the pre-requisite course/s with a grade/s of “B” or higher or
 - provide a signed letter of recommendation from the principal and guidance counselor attesting to the student’s suitability to take this course for college credit, and
 - provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian and electronic approval of the 1818 class instructor or 1818 Partner Coordinator
- c) Freshmen are not eligible to enroll in 1818 ACC courses.
