REPORTING COVID-19 ISSUES

IT IS IMPORTANT TO REPORT **ANY** COVID-19 ISSUE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE

If a student tests positive, gets exposed, or has Covid-19 like symptoms parents/guardians need to complete the following form to report the situation. Please allow up to 24 hours for the Covid-19 Liaison to contact you after completing the form.

COVID-19 issues will be confirmed with NVHD, we will require proof of testing, and/or proof of vaccination.

MASKS

Currently Ansonia School District is mask **OPTIONAL**, however, NVHD continues to encourage everyone to mask.

EXPOSURE OUTSIDE OF HOUSEHOLD

IF YOU

Were exposed to COVID-19
outside of your
household AND are
NOT experiencing ANY
symptoms (Regardless of vaccination status or previous infection).

Get tested

Individuals must <u>home test prior to reporting to school</u> AND agree to get <u>tested with a PCR test on or after day 5.</u> Negative test results must be sent to the COVID liaison BEFORE returning to school.

*If individuals are unable or unwilling to test they must quarantine for 10 full days from their LAST exposure.

Mask

Individuals must mask for 10 full days from their LAST exposure.

*If individuals are unable or unwilling to mask during this time (including children under age 2) they must guarantine for 10 full days.

Watch for symptoms

Individuals must watch for symptoms for a full 10 days after their last exposure.

Develop symptoms

Isolate immediately, stay home, contact your child's attendance office, and complete our **Student Covid-19 Reporting Form (Exposures, Symptoms, & Positive Case).**

IF YOU

Were exposed to COVID-19
AND you <u>ARE</u>
experiencing symptoms
(Regardless of vaccination status or previous infection).

Quarantine and Test

Individuals must <u>quarantine for a MINIMUM of 5 days</u> and <u>get tested on or after day 5</u> from the LAST exposure. Negative test results must be sent to the COVID liaison BEFORE returning to school.

*If individuals are unable or unwilling to test they must quarantine for 10 full days from their LAST exposure.

Mask

Individuals must <u>mask for 10 full days</u> from their LAST exposure.
*If individuals are unable or unwilling to mask during this time (including children under age 2) they must quarantine for 10 full days.

If symptoms resolve prior to day 5 individuals may return to school provided:

- They contact Nurse Monica the Covid-19 Liaison mskakacz@ansonia.org or 475-777-1938.
- They are fever-free (<100°F) for at least 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication).
- They do not live with anyone who tested positive for Covid-19 in the last 14 days.
- They can wear a mask CONSISTENTLY and CORRECTLY.
- They test negative with a home test prior to reporting to school AND they agree to get a PCR test on or after day 5. Negative test results must be sent to the COVID liaison BEFORE returning to school.

EXPOSURE WITHIN THE HOUSEHOLD

IF YOU

Were **exposed** to COVID-19 **within your household**

AND the positive Covid-19 household member

CANNOT isolate

(Regardless of your vaccination status or previous infection).

Quarantine and Test

Individuals must <u>quarantine for a MINIMUM of 5 days</u> and <u>get tested on or after day 5</u> from the LAST exposure. Negative test results must be sent to the COVID liaison BEFORE returning to school.

*If individuals are unable or unwilling to test they must quarantine for 10 full days from their LAST exposure.

Mask

Individuals must mask for 10 full days from their LAST exposure.

*If individuals are unable or unwilling to mask during this time (including children under age 2) they must quarantine for 10 full days.

IF YOU

Were **exposed** to COVID-19 **within your household**AND the positive Covid-19 household member **CAN isolate** (Regardless of your vaccination status or previous infection).

Are you experiencing ANY symptoms?

Individuals must <u>quarantine for a MINIMUM of 5 days</u> and <u>get tested on or after day 5</u> from the LAST exposure. Negative test results must be sent to the COVID liaison BEFORE returning to school.

*If individuals are unable or unwilling to test they must quarantine for 10 full days from their LAST exposure.

Mask

Individuals must mask for 10 full days from their LAST exposure.

Are you ASYMPTOMATIC (NO symptoms)?

Individuals must home test prior to reporting to school AND agree to get tested with a PCR test on or after day 5. Negative test results must be sent to the COVID liaison BEFORE returning to school.

*If individuals are unable or unwilling to test they must quarantine for 10 full days from their LAST exposure.

Mask

Individuals must mask for 10 full days from their LAST exposure.

*If individuals are unable or unwilling to mask during this time (including children under age 2) they must quarantine for 10 full days.

TESTING POSITIVE

IF YOU Test positive for COVID-19

(Regardless of your vaccination status or previous infection).

SYMPTOMATIC

Isolate

Individuals must isolate for a <u>MINIMUM of 5 FULL days</u> and return to school on day 6 ONLY IF symptoms are SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVING, symptoms do NOT have to be completely resolved, <u>AND</u> fever free (<100°F) for 24 hours without the use of medication.

Mask

Individuals must mask for 10 full days from their test date.

*If individuals are unable or unwilling to mask during this time (including children under age 2) they must quarantine for 10 full days.

ASYMPTOMATIC (NO SYMPTOMS)

Isolate

Individuals must isolate for a MINIMUM of 5 FULL days and return to school on day 6.

Mask

Individuals must mask for 10 full days from their test date.

*If individuals are unable or unwilling to mask during this time (including children under age 2) they must quarantine for 10 full days.

Calculating Isolation

Day 0 is your first day of symptoms or a positive viral test. **Day 1 is the first full day after your symptoms developed or your test specimen was collected**. **Calculating Quarantine**

The date of your exposure is considered day 0. Day 1 is the first full day after your LAST exposure with a person who tested positive for COVID-19.

When counting days Day 0 is the day an individual tests positive OR an individuals **LAST** exposure date.

For example:

Positive test date 4/20/22 (Day 0) Last exposure date 4/20/22 (Day 0)

Day 5 is 4/25/22 Day 5 testing date 4/25/22

Earliest return date 4/26/22 (Day 6) Earliest return date 4/26/22 (Day 6)

Travel Guidelines

Ansonia School District does **NOT REQUIRE** any testing after domestic or international travel. However, Ansonia School District **highly RECOMMENDS** students and staff follow **CDC Travel Guidelines**.
