Over-The-Counter Medication Consent**

Jesuit High School wants to keep your student in school and learning to every extent possible and, therefore, maintains a supply of basic over-the-counter medications to provide for your student's health and comfort should he or she become ill or injured at school. However, these medications can only be given to your student with your written/electronic consent. If this is a service you would like us to provide, please check the medications below you consider appropriate for us to give your student should the need arise.

You may have your consent discontinued or changed by notifying the registrar and/or School Health Nurse.

All medications are given in age/weight-appropriate dosages.

*I hereby give my permission for my student to be given the below checked medications at school on an "as needed" basis. I understand that this permission will remain in effect for the length of the academic year. I will notify the school if I want these medications changed or discontinued.*

*I am also aware that Benadryl, Epipens, and Albuterol may be kept on hand and will be dispensed in an age-appropriate dose should an apparent allergic and/or respiratory emergency arise from any cause.*

- Acetaminophen (Tylenol)-for pain relief
- Antacids (Tums/Roloids)-for upset stomach
- Antibiotic Ointment (Neosporin)-(topical use) for wound care
- Cough Drops (Ricola, Halls)-Menthol based for prolonged cough
- Diphenhydramine HCL (Benadryl)-Allergic Reaction
- Eye Drops (Visine)-for dry, itchy eyes
- Hydrocortisone Cream-Allergic Reaction
- Ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin)-for pain relief
