All Upper Cape Tech students will report to school on August 31, 2022. All grade 10, 11 and 12 students should report to their shop on the first day of school. Freshmen should report directly to the cafeteria. Schedules will be distributed at that time. [NOTE: Students will report directly to their first period class or shop, whichever is appropriate, after the first day of school.]

- **Bus schedules** will be printed in all local newspapers and posted on the Upper Cape Tech website (<u>www.uppercapetech.com</u>) prior to the opening of school. Plan to be at the bus stop closest to your home ten minutes before the scheduled time of arrival.
- Parent Student Handbooks / Agenda Books will be distributed during class meetings on the first day of school. This handbook will serve as the student handbook, the academic time management tool, and hall pass. This book must be kept available at all times during the school year. Students and their parents should read this handbook thoroughly and sign the designated page indicating they have read the rules and regulations of Upper Cape Tech.
- Student ID Badges Students are required to wear photo I.D.'s that are provided by Upper Cape Tech. New I.D. Badges will be distributed the first day of school and must be worn everyday. I.D. badges provide the school community a means to quickly identify who belongs in the building and who does not. Student I.D.'s shall be displayed on the upper body using only the safety lanyard provided by Upper Cape Tech. If lost, replacement ID badges can be purchased at the School Security Office \$5.00 for first replacement ID cards; \$10.00 for second and subsequent replacement ID cards.
- School Photos Wednesday, September 7, 2022
- School Insurance The School Committee has provided limited protection of school insurance for all Upper Cape Tech students under a blanket policy. Information regarding 24 hour coverage will be available on opening day and is also located on our website at www.uppercapetech.com.
- **Co-op** Students who were on **co-op work experience** at the end of the last school year should plan to report to Upper Cape Tech on the first day of school. Co-op students are required to **re-apply** through their co-op advisor before returning to co-op positions.



- School Lunch Program Lunch and breakfast will be served daily at no cost to students through the school year 2022-2023. For students who may qualify for free or reduced price lunch under Federal income guidelines, forms are available on the school website. <u>Whether you believe you are eligible or not, all students are encouraged to apply. This application should be completed and returned to the School Office on the first day of school.</u> You may also apply online and see your eligibility right away.
- Emergency Medical Information Student registration and medical forms are located on the Powerschool Portal. Please make sure to log in to your Powerschool account to update or change any information from the previous school year. <u>It is your responsibility to update any medical or emergency contact information regarding your student whenever there is a change.</u>
- Sports Information –All students are reminded that a parental consent form and current sports physical form must be on file in the Health Office before students will be able to participate in a fall sport. Parental consent forms can be filled out on FamilyID.com. For more information please visit the UCT website at <u>www.uppercapetech.com</u>. Athletics-UCT Sports Calendar or by emailing your coach.

All students should plan to have the following supplies available during academic week:

- notebook with appropriate paper
- scientific/fraction calculator

Shop instructors will advise their students re: appropriate shop attire and personal shop equipment.


