

Centering Prayer is a method of meditation used by Christians placing a strong emphasis on interior silence. It is also an ancient form of meditation with roots in monastic traditions of St. Teresa of Avila and St. John of the Cross. We begin with a prayer, are silent for 20 minutes while returning our focus to God, and end with a prayer. This takes 20-25 minutes and we meet at 12:30 on Wednesdays in the Chapel. Anyone is welcome to come regularly or drop in at that time.





It's hard to believe that St. James Episcopal School will be starting back to school next week and opening our doors for year five.

Over the past 4 years, St. James Episcopal School has continuously evolved from 20 students and 2 classes in 2018 to 93 students and 10 classes starting the 2022 school year.

I would like to thank our school office manager, Marcy Covington for her efforts in securing EANS grant funds for our school. This has allowed us to enhance our technology offerings providing Chromebooks and Viewsonic Smartboards for our elementary grades. Through this grant we were also provided with cleaning supplies and PPE for the staff and students if needed in the future. We have added 3 additional classrooms this year and 2 new enrichment classes to include Art and STEM. Needless to say we are utilizing every inch of space to continue our mission. We are proud to be the only Episcopal day school serving children ages 30 months through 3rd grade on the eastern shore.

St. James is a special place, and we have been blessed to afford many great opportunities for our students. Our

outstanding staff have been working hard preparing classrooms and attending workshops and professional development throughout the summer.

We are looking forward to a successful school year as we welcome new and returning students back to school.
