Policy Title: Graduation and Early Graduation

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It is the policy of the Board of Trustees that students who graduate from Post Falls High School will complete courses of instruction for a minimum of 46 semester credits.

Students in secondary schools shall be required to register for a minimum of six classes each day which may include one scheduled supervised study hall, unless excused by the administration of Post Falls School District if the student has met his/her requirements for graduation.

The date of graduation shall be approved annually by the Board of Trustees.

Early graduation requirements will be set forth in the procedures following this policy.
