The required courses for all high school students shall include:

English	8
Math	6
Speech	1
Science	6
U.S. History	2
American Government	2
Consumer Economics	1
Health	1
Humanities OR Practical Arts*	2
Physical Education	1
Required core instruction credits for graduation:	30
Required elective credits for graduation:	16

\* One humanities credit shall include a world history survey class.

A senior project including a written report and oral exam will be required by the end of grade 12.

A student will take the Idaho Student Achievement Test (ISAT) as defined by State Board rules.

**Early Graduation**

A student who completes all of the graduation requirements set forth by the Post Falls School District and the State Department of Education prior to the completion of eight semesters of school attendance in grades 9-12 may petition the local superintendent and Board of Trustees for early graduation. The student submits such a petition to the superintendent of schools through the building principal.

The superintendent shall submit the petition to the Board of Trustees for Board endorsement and approval at the end of the quarter preceding the requested graduation date.

Students must notify the school of their interest to graduate early.

Students who stay out of school the fall semester and attend the spring semester will be ineligible for athletics during the spring semester.

Students graduating from high school prior to the end of the school year will have the average daily attendance for the first semester counted as if they were in attendance during the second semester of the school year.
