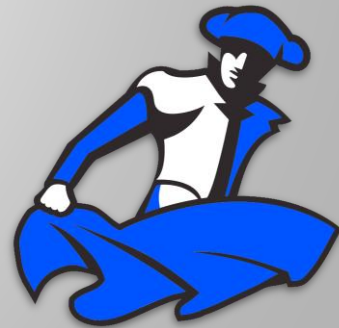
- **School Rules & Uniform Policy**

Uniform & Dress Code Policy



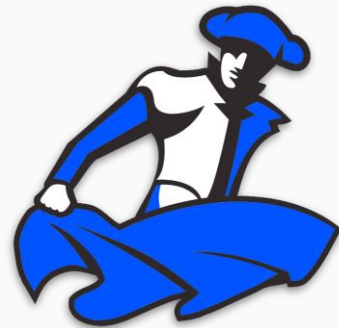
**Polo Shirts: Solid color - navy, black, white, gray,

NO HATS! NO HOODS! NO EXCEPTIONS!**

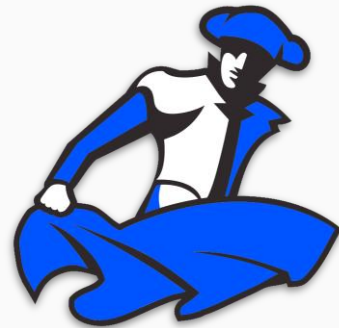

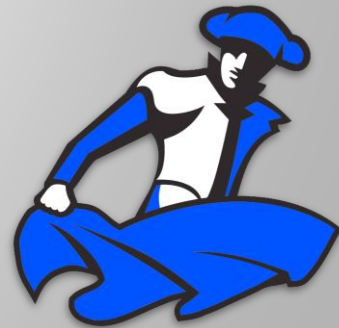

Warnings

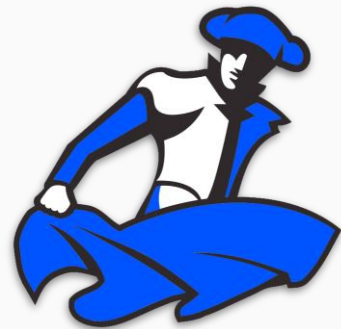
Detention

Suspension

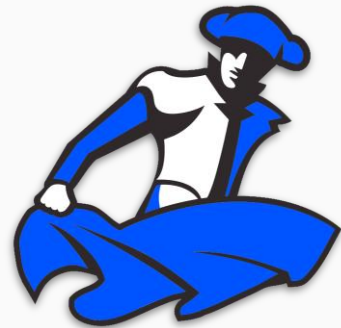
Placement



Teachers will implement their own consequences in their classrooms.

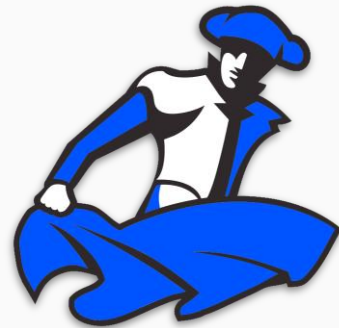
The office will determine additional consequences if students given a referral.

The goal: correct your behavior and refocus on succeeding in school.

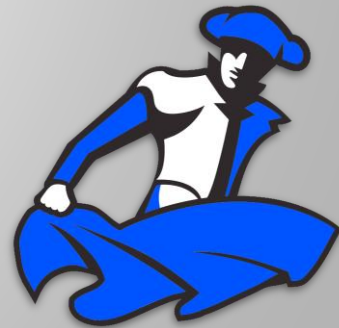


Credit Recovery for 7th and 8th Graders

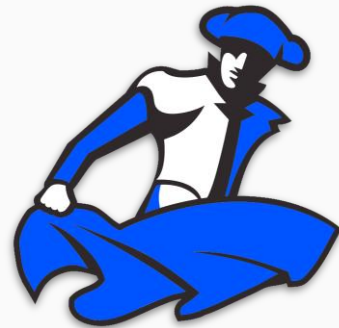

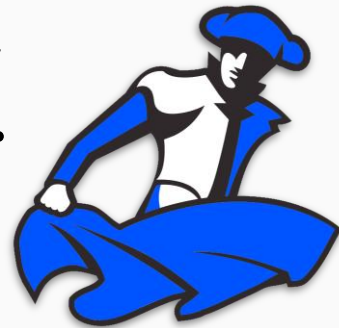
Reminders:
