## 2022-23 Profile for College Admissions Officers

- District** Olentangy Local School District, located in southern Delaware County, covers 95 square miles and remains one of the fastest growing districts in Ohio and in the nation. Olentangy Local Schools is ranked in the top 4% of all school districts in the state of Ohio.
- School** Olentangy Berlin High School opened in August of 2018 as a four year public high school with a present enrollment of 1669 students. There will be 388 students in the 2023 graduating class. Our school is too new to be included in any rankings.
- Faculty** Olentangy Berlin High School has 96 certified staff members, many of whom have earned a Master's Degree or beyond.
- Graduation Requirements** The curriculum at Olentangy Berlin High school is comprehensive including advanced placement, honors, occupational, and vocational programs. For the graduating class of 2023, twenty-two credits will be required. Specific requirements include elective courses and the required course of study:

- Honors & Advanced Placement** **Honors** courses are unweighted and are available in 9<sup>th</sup> grade English, 10<sup>th</sup> grade English, World History, U.S. History, Geometry, Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, Physical Science, Biology, and Chemistry.  
  
**AP** courses are weighted and are offered in World History, American Government/Politics, American History, English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, Seminar, Research, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics I, Physics/Mechanics, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics, Computer Science, Psychology, Art History, European History, Music Theory, Micro Economics, Macro Economics, Spanish, German and French.
- College Credit Plus** **CCP** courses are weighted and are specified with the college/university abbreviation, department abbreviation and course code.
