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2022-2023 Profile for College Admissions Officers

District Olentangy Local School District, located in southern Delaware County, covers 95 square miles and remains one of the fastest growing districts in Ohio and in the nation. Olentangy Local Schools is ranked in the top 4.1% of all school districts in the state of Ohio.

School & Faculty Olentangy Liberty High School, a nationally recognized "Blue Ribbon School of Excellence", is a four-year public high school (grades 9-12) with a present enrollment of 1897 students. There are 488 students in the 2023 graduating class. Olentangy Liberty High School is ranked in the top 2.6% of all high schools in the state of Ohio. Liberty High School has 115 certified staff. Of these, 86% have earned a Master's degree or beyond.

Graduation Requirements The curriculum at Liberty High School is comprehensive, including advanced placement, honors, occupational, and vocational programs. For the graduating class of 2023, twenty-two credits will be required. Specific requirements include elective courses and the following required course of study:

Honors, Advanced Placement & College Credit Plus Courses **Honors:** Algebra II, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, Biology, Chemistry, Physical Science, U.S. History, World History, College Prep English 9, College Prep English 10. Honors courses are not weighted.

Advanced Placement: Art History, Literature and Composition, Language and Composition, Seminar, Research, American Government/Politics, American History, European History, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Psychology, World History, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Computer Science A, Computer Science Principles, Statistics, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics 1, Physics C: Mechanics, Music Theory, Spanish, French, and German. Each instructor's syllabus has been audited and approved by the College Board. Advanced Placement courses are weighted on a 5.0 scale.

College Credit Plus courses are weighted and are specified with the college/university abbreviation, department abbreviation and course code.
