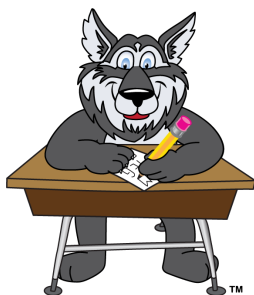

Switchboard Hours & Phone Calls

Our switchboard hours are from 7:30am to 3:30pm. If you need to speak to someone after 3:30pm during the school year, you may call the Activity Office at 651-482-5290. There is typically someone at that number until 5:00pm Monday through Friday. During the course of an average school day we receive multiple calls from parents who wish to talk immediately to their students. RAMS policy is to not interrupt class. If a student forgets something like homework or lunch, it can be dropped off at the main office. The student can then come and pick it up after their next class.

Incoming 7th graders who play on school owned instruments should have returned their elementary instruments to their elementary schools. They will be issued a RAMS instrument the first week of school. All students should have a music stand at home for practice - some music stands are available to check out from the school library.

Lockers

Each student is assigned a hall locker and a phy-ed locker, and they need a school lock for each. Students will get their hall locker assignment at Back To School Night. Those who do not attend orientation will get locker assignments in STAR on their first day of school. Phy-Ed locker assignments are made during the first week of school in student's phy ed class.

Locks will be available for purchase at Back To School Night and also in the Activity Office during the school year. You will need to purchase 2 locks - one for your hall locker and one for your gym locker. Locks cost \$10 for a pair of new locks with the same combination or \$1.00 each for used locks (used locks will not have the same combo). They will be available for purchase during the Back To School Night on Wednesday, August 31 in the Media Center. Non-school locks will be removed from lockers. We encourage all students to always lock their personal belongings.

ATTENDANCE

School attendance is important for student learning. RAMS uses an automated calling system for absences. If your student is marked unverified (absent) or tardy for ANY class period, you will receive an automated call that afternoon. Please use ParentVUE to check your student's attendance.

Reporting Absences

- Parent/Guardian should call 651-482-5281 or email ramsattendance@isd623.org each day the student is absent.
- When leaving your message, please include the student name, grade, reason for absence, your name and a contact number.
- If unable to call or email, send a note when the student returns to school.

Leaving Early/Appointments

Students should bring a note to the office BEFORE school starts in the morning. Students will be given a pass to leave class at the appropriate time and can sign themselves out in the office. Students should sign back into the office when returning.

Tardy To School

Students should sign in the office when arriving late to school. Students should have a note or a call from a parent/guardian. Doctor/Dental appointments should provide a clinic note for absences.

Vacations

If you are taking a student out of school for two or more days, please send a note or contact the office one week prior. The student will be given a "Leave Form" for teachers to sign and use to get homework.

Early Student Arrival

School starts at 8:05am. Students who do not ride the bus should arrive at school no earlier than 7:45am unless they have an appointment with a teacher.

TECHNOLOGY

iPad Program

Every student at RAMS receives an iPad for academic use. By receiving an iPad you and your student are agreeing to follow the district's expectations for student iPad use as found in the 1:1 iPad Program Family & Student Guide. Program goals and other information can be found at www.isd623.org/digitallearn. You can also find this information by going to the RAMS web page and clicking on 1:1 iPad Program under the "Families" tab.

2. Sign up for iPad insurance each year for each student at www.isd623.org/payonline

Technology support can be found at bit.ly/ramstech4students, and questions about the 1:1 iPad Program can be directed to the 1:1 iPad Program Coordinator by completing the form at www.isd623.org/digitallearn. Students who leave RAMS during the school year MUST return the iPad and school issued charger before leaving or the family will be charged for the full replacement value. If the iPad is not returned and/or the value is not paid within two weeks of leaving RAMS, formal charges will be filed.

STUDENT SCHEDULES

Student schedules can be found in StudentVue and ParentVue, also called Synergy. Sign into StudentVue using the students district username and password. The username is the first 6 letters of the student's last name and the first 5 letters of the first name in this format: llllllffff If the last or first name are shorter than 6 or 5 letters use the shorter amount of letters. Example: llffff

The password default is the students birthday in this format: mmddyyyy. Once you are logged into StudentVue click on "Class Schedule" found on the left side of links.

Personal Electronic Device/Backpack Policy

All personal electronic devices and backpacks need to be locked in student lockers from 8:05am to 2:40pm. This includes passing time and lunch time. If you need to contact your student during the school day, you may call the main office and we will contact them at the end of the next class period.

If a personal electronic device is out during the day, it will be collected by the behavioral staff and may be picked up by your student at the end of the day. If the device has been taken away before, a parent/guardian will be asked to pick it up from the office.

NUTRITIONAL SERVICES

Free Meals For All Are Ending

Our school nutrition staff looks forward to welcoming students back to school! We will continue serving healthy school meals to fuel our students for success. During the pandemic, federal waivers allowed schools to offer free meals to all students. Those waivers expired on June 30th, we now must charge families for meals unless they apply for and are approved to receive meal benefits. Households will need to complete an Application for Educational Benefits to see if they qualify for no-cost meals (link below).

Educational Benefits/Free and Reduced Lunch:

We implore ALL families to fill out the Application for Educational Benefits form (previously called Free/Reduced Meal Application) EVERY year. This form determines **funding for your child's school** and provides direct benefits for your child if you qualify. Benefits include funding for:

- Social workers, paraprofessionals and counselors
- Decreased student to instructor ratios
- Increased technology (at home Internet discounts)
- Waived fees for athletics, testing and transportation for your child

Each year a new application for Educational Benefits and Free/Reduced price meals needs to be completed. **These completed forms not only provide meal benefits but can help RAMS get crucial funding.**

- **A new application must be completed EACH YEAR.**
- Applications can be completed online at <https://family.titank12.com/> or you can request a paper copy. You can fill out a new form any time your family's income changes.
- Paper applications can be returned to the RAMS Office or mailed to Nutrition Services at the District Center, 1251 West County Road B2, Roseville, MN 55113

- This form not only determines benefits for students and families such as no-cost meals at school but also provides free bus cards, discounted internet service, discounted/no-cost early childhood classes and scholarships for summer camps and childcare centers, discounted field trips, standardized test fee waivers, and sports team scholarships and fee waivers.
- Educational Benefits also impacts your school's funding and the district's budget including state and federal dollars that may be used for administration, social workers, family liaisons, and more! The results of these applications are crucial to funding for things like Title 1, compensatory revenue, and summer and non-school day meals.

In addition this can afford your school money for family engagement, early childhood programs, professional development opportunities for staff, direct instructional services, remedial instruction services in reading, language arts, mathematics, study skills, additional teachers and teacher aides, lower instructor to learner ratios, out of school time programming, instructional materials, digital learning, truancy reduction programs, bilingual and bicultural programs, and all day Kindergarten

Lunch Account Procedures

Students purchase all meals and snacks by depositing enough money in an account to cover what the student chooses to eat each day. Students are assigned a "PIN" number (same as their Student ID) that they memorize and keep confidential, and enter into a keypad at the cashiers stand. If you do not know your student's school ID, please email food@isd623.org.

Payment Methods

Please check breakfast/lunch accounts frequently. Make checks payable to RAMS Nutrition. Money can be left in the "birdhouse" in the main office and should include the student's name and pin number. Deposits made before 10:00am will be available for use that day. Parents may also use a credit card by logging onto <https://family.titank12.com/>.

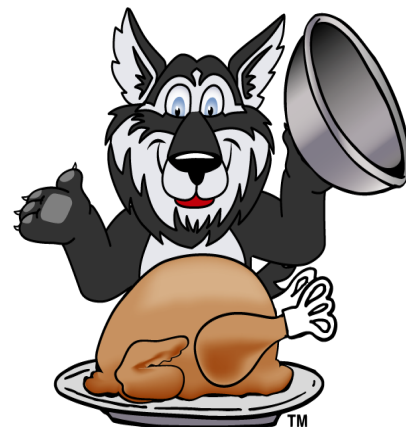

Breakfast

Breakfast is available daily in a grab-and-go style that students take to their 1st period. Students should enter directly from the bus through Door #4 marked “Cafeteria”, and may eat in the cafeteria from 7:45am to 8:00am. Options may include breakfast burritos, smoked turkey & cheese croissants, yogurt & whole grain muffin, low sugar cereals, mini pancakes, strawberry cream cheese filled bagel bars, breakfast sandwiches and more with daily options of fruit, milk, and 100% juice.



Lunch

Lunch will include a daily rotating option, a weekly hot grill line, and a weekly vegetarian option. Each meal features whole grains, lean proteins, vegetables, fruit, and a milk. We'll have favorites like the crispy chicken patty, honey sriracha boneless chicken wings with waffles, cheeseburgers, Caprese sliders, and all-beef hot dogs on the grill line as well as the all-time most-loved items like pizza, chicken drumsticks, brunch-for-lunch, macaroni & cheese, nachos, Mandarin orange chicken, and pasta with beef Bolognese sauce. Students are required to take at least three items with one item being a fruit or vegetable. We make it easy with our fruit and veg bar offering a variety of fresh options. Again this year, we will be featuring *twice* monthly all-local menus on our Minnesota Thursdays! We'll be using local produce, dairy, grains, and proteins to support our local farmers.

Super Snack

A free, after school snack will again be available in the cafeteria between 2:40-2:50pm to all students staying on site after hours for school sanctioned activities.

Outside Food Deliveries

There shall be no deliveries intended for students during school hours, unless pre-approved by administration. All delivery services will be turned away and any penalty costs will be the responsibility of the person who placed the order, not the school.

Medications

All regularly prescribed medication as well as non-prescription medication (e.g. ibuprofen/Tylenol) taken by students must be dispensed through the Health Office. Inhalers for the treatment of asthma and allergy emergency medication (e.g. Epi-pen, AvuiQ) may be carried by the student with the proper authorization from a healthcare provider and school nurse. We recommend to always have one set of a student's emergency medication in the health office. All students who request permission to self-carry must first be assessed by the school nurse. Students are not permitted to share medication with anyone else.

A new medication permission form is required each school year.

Immunizations

Minnesota School Immunization law requires documentation of immunizations to be on file at school prior to the start of school. Students entering 7th grade typically need to get the “7th grade boosters” of 1 Tdap (tetanus) vaccine and 1 meningitis vaccine. Need to know if your student is ready with the vaccines at their age group? [Click here](#) to be directed to a chart from MDH with vaccine information (<https://www.health.state.mn.us/people/immunize/basics/readykidswhento.pdf>).

A statement from a healthcare provider is required for a medical exemption from vaccinations. A notarized parent/guardian signature is required for any exemption due to religious or philosophical considerations. Each exemption statement must list the specific vaccines that the student will not receive. [This MDH immunization form](#) has a section for documentation of exemptions. The school health office can provide you with that form.

COVID: Please note that COVID vaccination is NOT required for school. However, if your student receives a COVID vaccine, please share the date with the school health office so we can update their school immunization record.

Because of the COVID-19 we understand that many of our incoming students did not get their "7th grade shots" last year. Please check your child's record and make sure they have all of the following:

All 7th and 8th graders are required to show proof of the following:

- 3 Hepatitis B doses

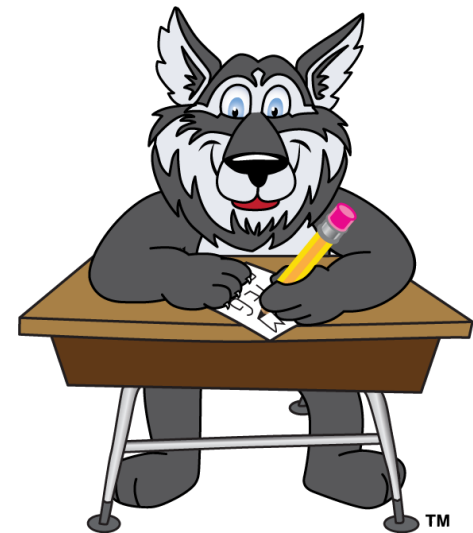
- 1 Tdap and 2 Tetanus and Diphtheria doses
- 3 Polio doses
- 2 Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) doses
- 1 Meningococcal dose
- 2 Varicella doses or a record from the doctor of having had the chickenpox

Please notify your school health office whenever your child receives a vaccination. It is important that we maintain accurate immunization records. If you have any questions about which vaccines your student needs, contact the school health office at 651-482-5291. Nutrition / Food Allergies

Students who have food allergies need to contact the school nurse. We will make every effort to provide gluten free or dairy free items. Please submit a Special Diet Food Request form to your healthcare provider to be returned to the Nutrition Service Department at District Center at the district center to authorize substitutions. No alternatives will be made without a Special Diet Food Request form on file. 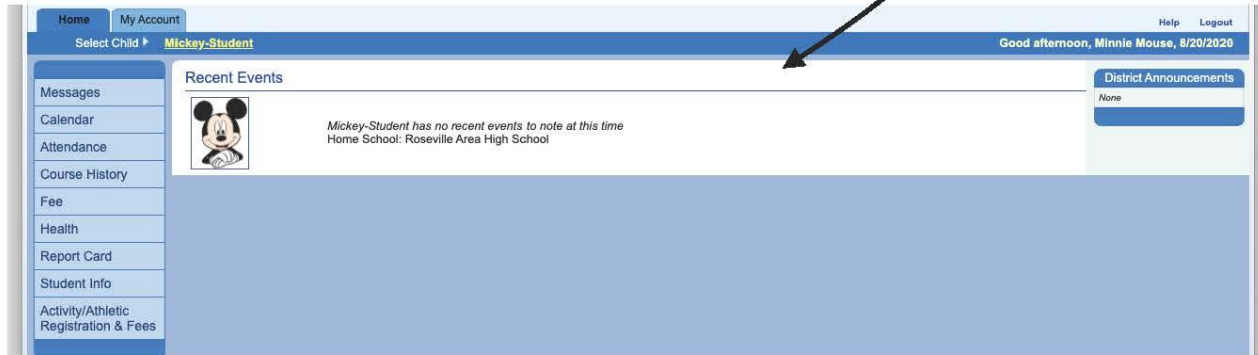

Welcome parents! Once you have received your login information from the district for Synergy ParentVue, we are asking you to check that your Contact information and Health information is correct. Here are some ideas for checking this information...

Once you log in, your home screen will look something like this:



When you click on the 'Health' folder in the column on the left, you will get a screen that looks something like this-listing health conditions we know about, if any.



Students that are **brand-new to our DISTRICT may not have health conditions documented in the system for a month or so; (if you filled out the New Student Health Questionnaire, we will get that information).**

Next, please toggle to the 'Immunizations' tab on the Health page.

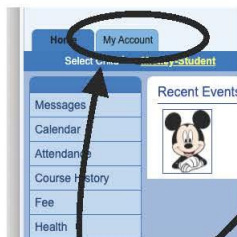

ACTIVITIES/ATHLETICS

After School Activities

A list of available extracurricular activities will be posted on the RAMS website. The selection of activities varies each year depending on what is proposed by staff and members of the community. Students must register and pay Online. Activities may have different fees, depending on length and other expenses.

Some activities meet in the morning before school, but most will take place after school. This makes it very difficult for a student to be in both a sport and an after-school activity during the same session. A student can jump into some activities mid-session when his/her sport season ends.

In the past RAMS has offered academic clubs like Science Club, International Club, Hmong Writing; academic teams like Destination Imagination, Future Problem Solvers, Math Counts; performing arts like Morning Choir, Jazz Band, Theater; creative arts like Pottery Club, Painting Club, Anime Club, athletic activities like Rock Climbing, Ultimate Frisbee, Badminton; and game clubs like Chess Club, Trading Card Club.

Unity Center

Unity Center is an afterschool program available to RAMS students federally funded by 21st Century Community Learning Center grants. The goal of this grant is to bring “learning to life” by uniting as a community to see that all of our students have the opportunity to learn, earn and lead.

Unity meets Monday through Thursday from 2:50pm-5:00pm and runs from late September through late May. There is no cost and after school snacks are provided. Regular attendance is required. Activity Buses

RAMS offers transportation within district 623 for students who stay after school to participate in athletics, activities, academic help or detention. A bus pass is required to board any activity bus. Students staying after for academic reasons should request 1-day pass from their teachers, which they give to the driver when boarding. Students staying after for regular activities like sports or theater should request a seasonal pass from the coach or director. If the seasonal pass is lost, a replacement can be obtained from the adult supervisor of the activity.

Students who are not directly involved in a supervised activity are expected to leave school at the end of the day. Students are not allowed to leave RAMS property and then return to school to ride the activity buses.

Maps of the activity bus routes are posted by the Activity Office and Media Center. There are no predetermined stops. Drivers follow set routes and pull over at safe locations when asked. The buses leave from the front of the school at the following times Monday through Friday:

- Bus 1, 4:10pm = To RAHS and then the west end of the district
- Bus 2, 4:20pm = East area of the district
- Bus 3, 4:20pm = Middle area of the district

There are also two late activity buses Monday through Thursday. There are no late activity buses on Fridays.

- Bus 1, 5:15pm = West end of district
- Bus 2, 5:15pm = East end of district

Sports Physicals

To register for a sport, a student MUST have an updated Sports Physical Form (within the last 3 years) entered into the registration program by the activity office. These physicals must note that the student is cleared by their physician to play sports. Please contact the Athletic Office if you are unsure if your physical is up to date. Refund Policy

In case of a major injury or a move out of the district during the first half of the season, 100% of the fee will be refunded. No refund will be granted after the midpoint of the season. There will be no refunds after the first game for athletes who quit voluntarily or who are removed from participation for attendance or other disciplinary reasons.

Reduced Fees

Practices/Games

Practices are every school day, normally from 3-5pm on Monday through Thursday, no practices on Friday.

Transportation will be provided to and from all away games, but athletes will need to provide their own transportation home from RAMS on game nights. This also pertains to home games as they end after the activity buses have left.

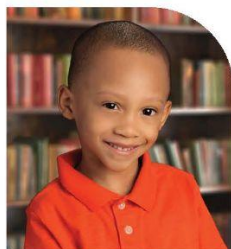

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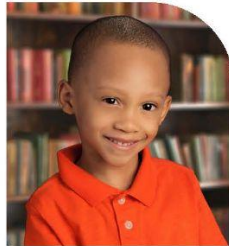
