

EXPLORE: The 4-Year Plan

The 4-Year Plan is the culmination of all exploration that occurs in middle school. It combines the information from 4 activities :

- Career Key
- Career Cluster Finder
- Endorsement Selection
- Guthrie Visits

Based on the knowledge gained during their middle school years, the student selects a Program of Study that aligns with a potential sequence of courses that once completed, increases the preparation towards a postsecondary credential.

EXPLORE: Naviance

Students use Naviance to gain understanding about their personal interests, aptitudes and abilities and align them with the opportunities that SBISD has to offer and build a successful plan.

- Naviance Career Key
 - **Career Key** is a **career** assessment that enables students to identify careers and college majors that match their interests, traits, skills and abilities
- Naviance CareerClusterFinder
 - The **Career Cluster Finder** is a simple assessment that helps a student discover which **career clusters** may be a good match based on activities that interest him or her, personal qualities the student has and subjects the student enjoys in school


