

- 1 wide-rule spiral bound notebook–Red-Reading*
- 1 wide-rule composition notebook–choice cover - Pen Pal*
- 1 Black permanent marker
- 1 dz sharpened #2 pencils
- 1 box of facial tissues
- 1 box of colored pencils*
- scissors
- 2 pack Black large dry-erase chisel point markers (about 4 markers per pack = 8 total)
- 1 sturdy pencil box or bag (NOT extra large - needs to fit in a small desk)
- 1 set small earbuds/headphones (store in labeled plastic baggie)
- backpack
- earbuds or earphones (corded, not bluetooth) for testing, place in baggie with name

5th Grade

- 1 Graph paper notebook*
- 1 File Portfolio, trapper keeper, that has folders inside for organization (a minimum of 5 folders inside that can be labeled –we will label them at school)
- 1 composition book (science, social studies and writing)
- 1 box of facial tissues*
- 3-4 dozen #2 pencils **(Please have 1 dozen sharpened and ready to use prior to the first day of school. We will ask for the next dozen around December or as needed)*
- 1 pkg colored pencils
- 2 erasers (rectangular shape)
- 1 non-electrical pencil sharpener with shavings container
- 1 package markers
- 1 pencil box (IF NEEDED to put loose supplies in)
- Earbuds/headphones (corded, not bluetooth) for testing placed in a baggie labeled with your child’s name can be kept in their locker or at home until testing

Optional donation: ream of blank white paper.

*Some items such as graph paper and facial tissues will be collected and put together for class use. *You do not need to label these items.*
