



Learn to Draw

Fall 2022 and Winter-Spring 2023

Students (Gr. 1-5) will be given instruction in developing basic drawing skills by learning techniques and improving their observational skills through proportion, perspective, and contrast. Classes will be sketchbook-based with the emphasis on process. We will draw traditional subjects: the figure, objects, and landscapes using graphite and colored pencils as well as chalk pastels. Due to COVID-19, students will have their own personal art supplies (\$30 one-time fee) that they can take home at the end of the session.
