### **Principal's Update/Start of the School Year:**

- Start has gone well, absences - everyone working together
- Morning recess has started - Coach Brady has been teaching students expectations with equipment, supervision (staffing) has worked well
- PBIS - golden Eagles, silver Eagles - name drawings, announcements - positive recognition - grade level and school level (school assemblies) - Ideas for donations - Church, teen center,

Kiwanis, Angie (SEL), Elks Club, etc.

- Math specialists communicating with teachers about assessments and setting groups
- Reading specialist - assessing students

**Budget 2022-2023:**

- M/O money (consumables, salaries) - \$22,117
- M/O - \$7,000 for copies not including paper which is about \$7,000
- M/O - \$5 student plus \$2 science - given to classroom teachers
- Most money is not in M/O - Capital (\$18,000) and Bond (\$16,000)
- Capital - curriculum, but not consumables
- Bond - furniture and equipment
- ESSER money - did not purchase smart boards, secured 1.5 math specialist
- Amp/Mic systems teachers are using with much success

**Tax Credit Classes:**

- Running, Homework, Rubix, Robotics, STEM, Coding, Good News Club (Chris), Yearbook
- Putting out to staff to volunteer to have these clubs
