### **UNIFORMS & DRESS CODE**

Student behavior, school pride, and academic performance are influenced by what is worn to school each day. We hope to maintain school safety, cohesiveness and a sense of belonging and unity with our uniform policies and are counting on your support. For students who arrive out of uniform, parents will be called to bring a uniform. The following policy has been implemented:

**1st Violation:** Teacher contact parent to request a uniform be brought to the school. Documented as classroom managed incident in Educator's Handbook.

**2nd Violation**: Teacher contact parent to request a uniform be brought to the school. Teacher sends uniform violation letter home. Documented as classroom managed incident in Educator's Handbook.


**3rd Violation**: Teacher notifies Social Worker. Social Worker contact the parent directly. Teacher sends uniform violation letter home. Documented as classroom managed incident in Educator's Handbook.

#### 4th And Subsequent Violation: Office Referral

<ul> <li>Plain collared shirts in red, white, or navy blue.</li> <li>Pants, shorts, skirts, skorts in khaki or navy blue.</li> <li>Socks, leggings, or tights</li> <li>Plain red, white, or navy-blue jacket without hood worn inside during the day. Plain jean jackets are appropriate.</li> <li>Sneakers, closed-toe shoes, and shoes with a closed heel or strap.</li> <li>Outerwear of any kind may be worn to school.</li> <li>Lady's Island spirit wear may be worn everyday with uniform bottom (shirt, sweatshirts, hoodies)*</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Non-spirit wear hoodies</li> <li>Jackets that contain writing, hoods, or are not school colors.</li> <li>Outerwear/heavy coats worn inside</li> <li>Shorts, skirts, skorts shorter than fingertip length.</li> <li>Jeans **</li> <li>Jeans with holes/rips are not allowed</li> <li>T-shirts or shirts without collars**</li> <li>Cargo pockets in pants/shorts</li> <li>Shoes with wheels</li> <li>Flip flops, crocs, clogs, sandals, or open-toed shoes</li> <li>Hats, bandanas, and accessories that are distracting, such as big flowers, vests that are not school colored</li> <li>Large hoop earrings</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>*Spirit wear may be worn with a uniform bottom any day of the week.</li> <li>**On designated spirit days: <ul> <li>Each Friday is a spirit day</li> <li>School spirit shirt, sweatshirt, or hoodie</li> <li>Jean or uniform bottoms. Jeans with holes/rips are not allowed.</li> <li>Other items as requested (i.e. hat day)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	

#### On uniform free Days:

Any appropriate shirt/jeans. Shoes must still be sneakers or closed toe and shorts must be fingertip length.
