Amity Happenings

Summer break is drawing to a close, and we hope you all made the most of the good weather and time away from school. The dedicated and talented faculty and staff of Amity Regional High School returned to campus for the school year this week, and after a week preparing for our students, we are excited to welcome everyone back on Monday, August 29.

Our Link Crew 9th grade orientation program and cookout took place today, and it was great to see the excitement and enthusiasm of the newest Spartans to enter Amity, the Class of 2026. It takes many people to stage a program like this, so “thank you!” to the Link Crew advisors, the 80+ students who have volunteered to serve as Link Crew leaders, all of the faculty and staff who showed up to run the cookout, and the support of the PTSO for making it possible.

Important Start-of-the-Year Reminders

- **Student Schedules** are available for all students online through the student and parent portals on PowerSchool. To help keep Amity as environmentally low-impact as possible, we do not print out paper copies of individual student schedules and ask that everyone access their class schedules through the portal instead.
- **Bell Schedules** for the first two days of school are available [Here](#) . Both days will include a mix of classes and grade-wide activities, and on Monday all students should report to their Spartan Seminar location to start the day. The school day begins at 7:34 am.
- **Senior Parking Spaces:** We are looking forward to seeing the creativity of our Seniors on display as they have the opportunity to paint their parking spots for the first time this fall. As a reminder, Seniors may only paint their spots after they have completed the parking application, submitted a sketch of their design through the Grade 12 Google Classroom, and had it approved.
- **Morning Drop-Off and Afternoon Pick-Up:** If you are dropping off or picking up your child rather than having them take the bus or drive themselves to school (only students in grades 11-12 can drive to school), it is important to enter only from the back entrance (North Pease Road). Vehicles will exit out the front driveway (Newton Road) after dropping off or picking up students on the side of the building. Traffic is always heavy at the start of the school year, so make sure to account for that in your planning if you will be driving your child to school.

Students who complete and document 100 hours of community service hours over the course of their 4 years at Amity High School will receive a certificate of recognition and an honor cord on the day of their graduation.
